Annual Thanksgiving Collection

Continuing with our parish tradition, Fr. Wayne has graciously designated this year's parish Thanksgiving collection for the benefit of our Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP), St. Francis Xavier/St. Joseph Conference. **We need your help more than ever this year.**

Assisting individuals and families in financial or personal crisis is the Society's number one mission. There are many people who find themselves in serious and often unforeseen financial difficulty due to medical conditions and expenses, job loss, resettlement, or other events. They are at risk of eviction, a utility shut-off or simply in need of food, household goods or transportation.

The COVID-19 pandemic has made circumstances harder for many families. Within our own community, we have seen a family hit hard with medical bills after a father lost his job and health insurance, a single mother struggling to pay bills while navigating online school for her child with learning disabilities, and penniless refugees in our sharing parish lacking coats, blankets and clothing needed for Chicago's freezing winters. These are just a few examples of how the lives of many have been turned upside down by the coronavirus and unforeseen events this year.

Vincentians interview prospective clients and decide how best to support them in getting back on their feet. For example, the Society may participate in a rent payment, cover a utility bill, provide a pre-loaded gas, grocery, or transportation card, or direct the client to other service providers. Many have been vetted by and referred to us by a handful of nearby social service organizations working to address the client's longer-term needs.

We help in a way that is compassionate, confidential, discreet, efficient, and swift while preserving the client's dignity and privacy. Moreover, Vincentians collaborate with other Saints JFX parish ministries to serve clients. Most notably, the Women's Club made prayer blankets that were blessed and given to families suffering from illness in the refugee community. Also, the Women's Club served several meals alongside our SVdP Society at the Catholic Charities supper for the homeless and less fortunate.

The Society's mission also includes: sponsoring and serving meals to homeless at soup kitchens (Catholic Charities and St. Stans), visiting patients weekly at the Shirley Ryan AbilityLab and assisting them in getting to Mass, bringing flowers to the homebound during the holidays, making referrals to organizations that offer additional services such as Catholic Charities, Connections for the Homeless, and the North Shore Senior Center, and ongoing work with the schools of St. Thomas of Canterbury and St Mary of the Lake.

It is your support, through the Thanksgiving collection, that enables the needs of many to be met, building a short bridge to families and individuals who need one.
