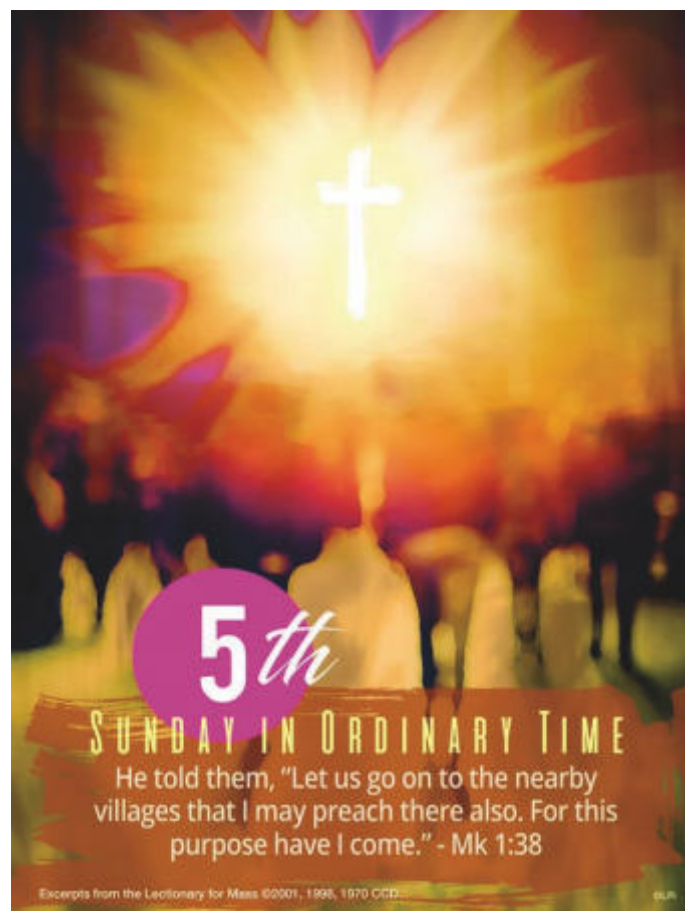




## Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish

Dear Friends,

Don't we all want a purpose in Life? Eighteen years ago, Rick Warren, an Evangelical pastor, wrote a book called, *A Purpose Driven Life: What on Earth Am I Here For*. The book, and the many self-help guides that followed in its wake, found their strength in our culture's desire for purpose or meaning in our lives – a good thing, wouldn't you say?

In our search for purpose or meaning, though, we often find ourselves looking in the wrong places. Some think they have to be really good athletes to have purpose. Others long for popularity. Still others think that one's purpose, one's significant meaning directly relates to the paycheck she or he brings home. Our hunt often becomes absorbed in the self. And then we get lost. We become a bit like the Job we meet in today's first reading, as he laments the drudgery of life. He wonders if he will ever see happiness again. He expresses a loss of a sense of purpose, and, along with it, a serious lack of joy.

Warren proposes five purposes (and none of these is self centered): We were planned for God's pleasure. We were formed for God's family. We were created to become like Christ. We were shaped for serving God. We were made for a mission.

Today's scriptures invite us to lose ourselves and to get caught up in the stewardship God gives us. Saint Paul tells us how he responded to the stewardship. He speaks of the necessity of preaching the Gospel and the consequences for him if he doesn't. That call to preach the Gospel didn't end 2000 years ago with Paul and his contemporaries. Each of us has the responsibility of supporting the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ. We've all been entrusted with great responsibility. Paul calls it stewardship; Cardinal Cupich calls it responsibility. Whatever one calls it, the action steps remain the same. We must give of ourselves in advancing the Gospel.

I recently returned to Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation, *The Joy of The Gospel*. I suggest (maybe for Lent) you get a copy and read it. The Pope writes in such a plain and approachable way. In the exhortation, the Pope speaks to all people of faith: to bishops, priests, deacons, religious – especially to the lay people! He calls all of us to participate in the mission of evangelization. He reminds us that we evangelize by the way we live our lives. Even though we lack perfection, God still calls us and still wants us to participate in such a great task. I share with you an excerpt from the exhortation.

*"In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (cf. Mt 28:19). All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization, and it would be insufficient to envisage a plan of evangelization to be carried out by professionals while the rest of the faithful would simply be passive recipients. The new evangelization calls for personal involvement on the part of each of the baptized. Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God's saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love. Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus... So what are we waiting for?"*

*Of course, all of us are called to mature in our work as evangelizers. We want to have better training, a deepening love and a clearer witness to the Gospel. In this sense, we ought to let others be constantly evangelizing us. But this does not mean that we should postpone the evangelizing mission; rather, each of us should find ways to communicate Jesus wherever we are. All of us are called to offer others an explicit witness to the saving love of the Lord, who despite our imperfections offers us his closeness, his word and his strength, and gives meaning to our lives. In your heart you know that it is not the same to live without him; what you have come to realize, what has helped you to live and given you hope, is what you also need to communicate to others. Our falling short of perfection should be no excuse; on the contrary, mission is a constant stimulus not to remain mired in mediocrity but to continue growing.*

In his exhortation, the Pope challenges all of us to accept the responsibility our Lord has given us. We must reject the "someone else can do it" attitude. You and I must do it – whatever the "it" is! That's what we are here for. That's the purpose that drives our life.
