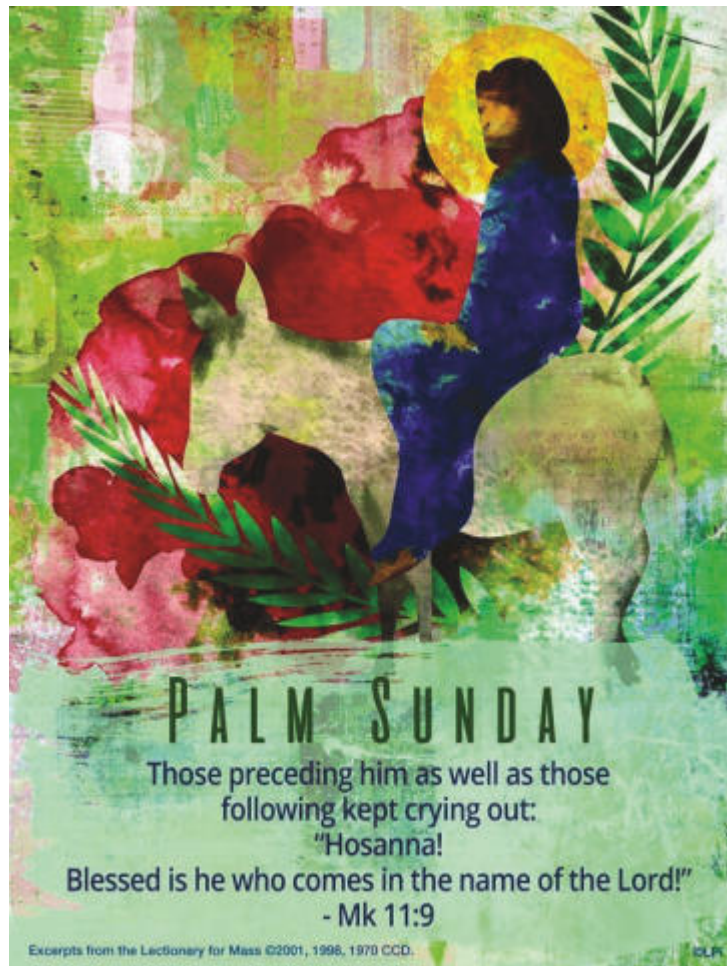




Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish

Dear Friends,

Over the last several days we have had hints of spring, a touch of summer and a reminder that winter can still bite us. And we are on the outer (I hope!) edges of a global pandemic. In the midst of it all, the Church Universal prepares for the springtime of Easter. We've almost made it! According to Archdiocesan Covid-19 guidelines, we are doing away with the Solemn Palm Sunday Entrance Procession this year. I will miss it. So, I insert the words from the Roman Missal that you will not hear this weekend. Let's take them to heart.

Dear brothers and sisters, since the beginning of Lent until now we have prepared our hearts by penance and charitable works. Today we gather together to herald with the whole Church the beginning of the celebration of our Lord's Paschal Mystery, that is to say, of his Passion and Resurrection. For it was to accomplish this mystery that he entered his own city of Jerusalem. Therefore, with all faith and devotion, let us commemorate the Lord's entry into the city for our salvation, following in his footsteps, so that, being made by his grace partakers of the Cross, we may have a share also in his Resurrection and in his life.

So many people have asked how the Church determines the date of Easter each year. The answer might surprise you. It involves the sun and the moon. In the Roman Catholic Church we celebrate Easter on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox. The vernal equinox occurred last Saturday morning, March 20th. The first full moon of spring is actually today, Sunday, March 28th, and the first Sunday after that is April 4th. Church days begin at sundown on the evening before the actual day. So, Saturday April 3rd, at sundown, we will begin our Easter festivities at Saints JFX (which, by the way, last for fifty days!). I hope you'll join us – in person or virtually.

Much happens, though, before Saturday's sundown. Today we enter the holiest week of our liturgical year. We join Jesus as he prepares for his passion death and saving resurrection. If we had a processional Gospel, which we normally read after blessing the palms, we would listen as Jesus instructs his disciples to go ahead of him and prepare the Passover.

The disciples do exactly as Jesus commands. In doing so, they unleash the drama of the Paschal Mystery. Perhaps unwittingly they participate in the saving power of Christ's selfless love. Those words of Jesus and the actions of his imperfect disciples urge us to join him on his journey this week - and throughout our lives.

We can learn a lot about life and living in Christ in the Letter to the Philippians. Jesus turned the Jewish expectation of Messiah upside down. He came, not as royalty, but in poverty. He served, rather than allowed himself to be served. He lived humbly and obediently. What we learn from the Suffering Servant, and from the Passion of Christ, though, may direct us in a different way than we *want* to go, certainly in a way contrary to the way modern society would have it.



Jesus does not refuse his divine vocation; he does the will of the Father, whether it is easy or difficult. Only when we humble ourselves do we allow God's Spirit to dwell in us. Only when we obey the Lord God do we find true freedom. Only when we empty ourselves can God fill us with his never-ending love. In our own personal and communal suffering, the Lord God will indeed be our help. Holy Week allows us to reflect on these truths. **The Passover of the Lord, the Paschal Mystery is upon us. Will you make this week holy?** Please do.

The pandemic has forced us to drastically reduce in-person worship this year, and most of the liturgies of the Triduum and Easter Sunday Mass have been fully subscribed. Hopefully, by the time you read this, we will have been able to expand the seating capacity for the Triduum liturgies. It's a balancing act between safely gathering and allowing those who wish to come in person to do so.

With a joyful hope, I invite you to revel in the accounts of everything that happens this week, whether you join us in person or on our YouTube channel. I cannot stress to you enough how important it is for Catholics to truly enter into the events of this week. April 1st - April 4, 2021 has the potential of changing us forever. Let's not just live as if it's just another week. Make this week holy.
