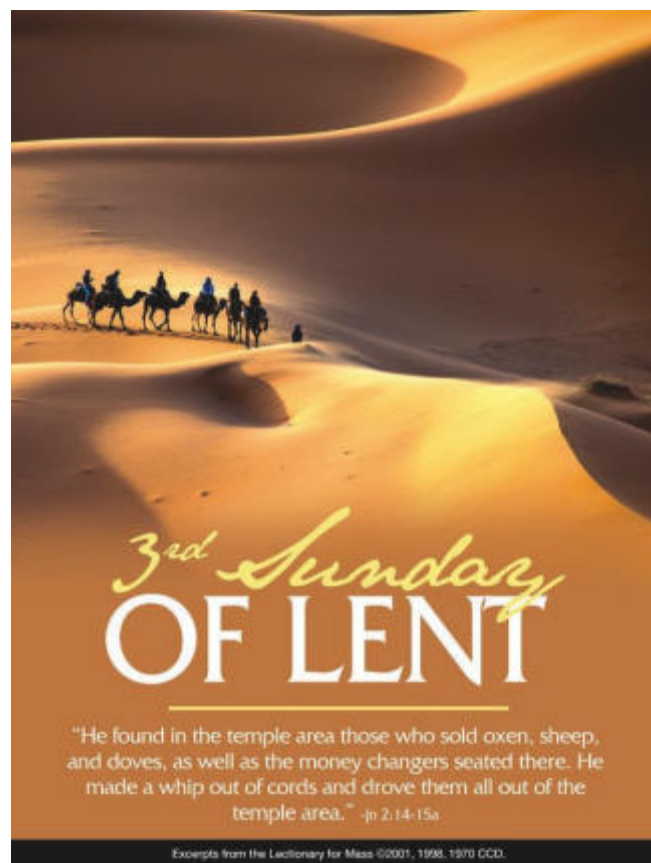




## Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish

Dear Friends,

The other day I was working with a bridal couple as they selected their readings for the Wedding Mass. The bride turned to me with a great deal of anxiety after reading a selection that included, "fear the Lord." The phrase upset her. A holy fear, a deep and profound respect for God and God's ways, and a sincere reverence leads us into a close relationship with our omniscient and omnipotent God.

For almost fifty years, popular Catholic catechesis has steered away from such terms. Of course, we always remember our God as loving and merciful, slow to anger and rich in kindness. We rely heavily on Saint John's assertion that "God is love." Indeed, He is. Occasionally, Sacred Scripture shows us the other side of God. The God who gives commands, the God who threatens punishment, the God who overturns tables in the temple, makes us a bit uncomfortable.

We want to be the ones to make orders. We want to be in control. We want to make our will be done. Today's readings rock our little boats. They move us out of our comfort zones. They urge us to humble ourselves and admit that we are not God! Listen to the strong voice of the Lord from the twentieth chapter of the book of Exodus.

*"I, the LORD, am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall not have other gods besides me. You shall not carve idols for yourselves in the shape of anything in the sky above or on the earth below or in the waters beneath the earth; you shall not bow down before them or worship them. For I, the LORD, your God, am a jealous God, inflicting punishment for their fathers' wickedness on the children of those who hate me, down to the third and fourth generation; but bestowing mercy down to the thousandth generation on the children of those who love me and keep my commandments."*

This *Torah*, or Law, given to Moses nearly 1300 BC, over three thousand years ago, set the stage for God's people to become a holy people. It established the covenant (again!) between God and the chosen people. Often though, even after their leader shared the words, the people turned from God. Their quest for holiness came second to their quest for other things. The chosen peoples' own will diluted God's will. And their actions had consequences.

The same goes today. Our liturgies remind us that we are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people God has chosen as his own. But we, too, allow our selfish will to get in the way of following God's commandments. I once heard someone reminding a congregation that on Mount Sinai came the Ten Commandments, not the Ten Suggestions! So often, though, we continue to rationalize our actions and refuse to allow anyone's (even God's!) rules to dictate the way we live our lives. We get offended when the Commandments, the Church, or anyone else challenges our way of life.

Jesus confronts the moneychangers, and those who were selling sheep, oxen and doves, to reform their ways and their lives and to restore the reverence and respect due to the Temple. We witness his righteous anger over the corruption that invaded the holy place. As we do, we must ask ourselves our own attitude toward God's house (and God's ways, for that matter). When we make our will and our ways more important than God's ways and God's will, don't we show the same irreverence and disrespect? Do we give our Lord cause for righteous anger? Is it time for us to change?

We *can* change when we reflect on the Cross. When we realize that Christ's ultimate act of obedience to the Father's will saved us and gave us an example by which we can live. We need to see the Cross as victory, and as love. Lent is the perfect time to do this.

**Finance Council (FC)** is a standing committee of parishioners who assist the Pastor in the administration of parish matters. Their mission is to promote the financial health of the parish and assure accountability to the parish. The council is open to all parishioners and strives to have a mix of professional backgrounds including, but not limited to, finance, accounting, legal, marketing, consulting, and fundraising from both parish and school individuals across a range of age groups. **Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)** is the main consultative body of the Parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes periodic reevaluation of the parish mission statement, defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission. The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as stewardship, hospitality, Church re-opening, Youth Faith Formation, and other Parish committees. This council has 12 members and terms are 3 years.

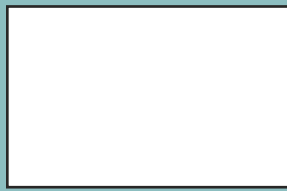
