



Dear Friends,

A couple of weeks ago, I was talking with a second grader after Mass. She told me, "I made my 'fifth Communion' today!" Her excitement and enthusiasm about receiving Holy Communion lit up the church. I wonder if she will still have the number in her head next year at this time. I hope that number will be approaching 100, with her regular Tuesday School Mass attendance, and a commitment by her parents to come every Sunday. That little one's enthusiasm, her desire to celebrate receiving the Eucharist, gives a great example to all of us.

So, we *celebrate* the Holy Eucharist. What's that? What is the Holy Eucharist? It is the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ that we receive in what appears to be bread and wine. Sometimes in the Church's desire to be accessible, or relevant, we can lose the mystery that faith has for us. How mysterious, how wonderful, how truly awesome is our God. He gives us his only Son who in turn offers us not only the Holy Spirit but his real self in the Eucharist. Real Presence.

That's what we celebrate today. Jesus comes to us, really, in the Eucharist. The Catholic Church teaches that frequent reception of the Eucharist is good for the soul because we receive the Body and Blood of Christ, "without whom you have no life in you."

How often do you reflect on the great gift of the Eucharist? When we come to Mass, we often leave reflecting on the quality of the music, on the message in the homily, albeit important elements of the Eucharistic celebration. But the really important thing is we receive the word of God in the Sacred Scriptures and the Son of God in the Eucharist. Even if the music is dull (never at Saints JFX!) or the homily boring (maybe once in a while!), receiving the Body and Blood of Christ makes the trip to church worthwhile. Christ's Body and Blood strengthen us and give us the grace to continue living as Christians in the world.

Grace. Most important of all, that is what God gives us in the Eucharist. In his true Eucharistic presence, Jesus gives us God's love freely poured out on us. What a great gift! What a wonderful reason to celebrate the feast.

As we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, this may be a good time to examine our own approach to Mass and reception of Holy Communion. The Mass rejoices in God's providence, even during a pandemic. Some people have written with concerns over the ways we have celebrated the Eucharist during this seemingly endless time of protections and protocols. Some even complain as they leave church after receiving Communion at Mass. I remind them how fortunate we are to be able to celebrate the Eucharist together in our churches and in our parking lots. I encourage gratitude and joy.

How joyful are you when you come to church? The Eucharist is centered on thanksgiving. Do you express your gratitude as we gather for the Eucharist? Do you actively participate in the prayers of the Mass?



At Communion time, we receive Jesus' Body and Blood. The theological term for what happens during the Eucharistic Prayer is "transubstantiation." The accidental qualities of looking, smelling, and tasting like bread and wine do not change. The real substance, the essence of the matter, changes from simple bread and wine to the Body and Blood of Jesus. What we receive as we approach the priest or minister IS THE BODY AND BLOOD OF JESUS! So today I ask you to think about what you receive. Be grateful for it. Be transformed by it. And believe. When you say "Amen," from this point onward, mean what you say. "So be it! I believe! Yes! To the Real Presence, the Body of Blood of Christ!"

I end with words from the Preface for today's Mass.

*Nourishing your faithful by this sacred mystery,
you make them holy, so that the human race,
bounded by one world,
may be enlightened by one faith
and united by one bond of charity.*

United in love, let us thank God for the gift of his Son in the Eucharist.
