Dear Friends,

How many of us ever want to *admit* to ourselves, let alone *boast* to the rest of the world of our weakness? Saint Paul, in today's second reading describes the "thorn in the flesh" and boasts of his weakness. He says that when he is weak, it is then that he is strong. Every single person has a thorn. Each of us can admit, if we are so inclined, a weakness.

I will never forget an experience I had several years ago. A friend of a friend asked to meet with me to discuss his spiritual life, and to talk about the possibility of his getting involved in my work at Catholic Charities. I didn't know this man well. I knew he was a good friend of a friend of mine, that's all. I had only met him briefly once before and wasn't sure I would recognize him. We met at my office and walked to lunch a few blocks away. As soon as we sat down at the restaurant table, he told me what the thorn in his flesh was. He revealed his profound personal weakness to a man he had only really met 10 minutes before. I'm not sure if he was hoping for me to reveal mine, but I distinctly remember that I did not.

That experience sticks with me. The humility of the man, and his honesty caused me to reflect on my own life and my own willingness to admit, at least to myself and my God, my "thorn." In 1984, the Gillette Company launched an ad campaign that still "has legs," as they say in the advertising world. If you were around in 1984, you will probably remember the tag line. "*Never let them see you sweat.*" I cannot even remember the product the ad was selling, but I do remember the line.

"*Never let them see you sweat.*" The philosophy behind the nearly 40-year-old line epitomizes our self-sufficient society, our radically independent mode of living. That philosophy says, "Don't let anybody know you are nervous! Don't let your guard down! Never, never reveal your weakness, to anyone!" Saint Paul, and the man with whom I met that day, would challenge that philosophy.

As we gather this week for Holy Mass, and as we listen to the Sacred Scriptures, God calls us to reflect on our own weakness, and to allow the power of God's love to give us strength. If we go through life thinking that we are so strong, we will deny our own need for a Savior. When we can admit our faults, failures, and weaknesses, when we acknowledge the "thorn," we will live more humbly. Living with humility, we adopt a poverty of spirit, recognizing that we are nothing without God, and all that we have and all that we are comes from a generous, loving God. God will give us what we need. God will use us, despite our weakness. We can become instruments of evangelization, mercy and grace. God's providence and omnipotence surpasses all our weakness, and when we allow him, God will transform us.

Pastoral Staff Updates

On July 1st, we welcomed Father Robert Ryan as our new Associate Pastor for Saints JFX. When I met him this week as he was moving in, he expressed an eagerness and an excitement to meet you, to work and pray with you, and to serve with you. He hit the ground running, celebrating 6:30 am Mass at Saint Francis on Thursday. Father Ryan will live at the Saint Joseph Rectory with Monsignor Mayall, and I will remain at the Saint Francis Xavier Rectory with Father Harnett. Please join me in warmly welcoming Father Ryan to this great community. He promises to be a wonderful addition to our team.



I think it is worth noting that while we are grateful for whatever help our retired priests give, we really only have two priests assigned as full-time ministers in this parish, Father Ryan and me. It is a good reminder to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We need more priests so that we can continue to celebrate the Eucharist with the regularity that we do. We claim that the Eucharist is the source and summit of Catholic life. Please pray that God will send more laborers into the field. Please encourage your children and grandchildren to listen for God's call and to respond with generous hearts.

With July, we begin a new fiscal year. We are budgeting a 5% increase in Sunday collections. I intend to increase my Sunday giving by 7%. I hope you will too. 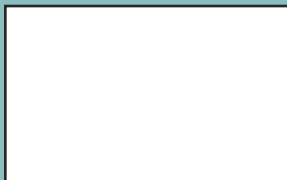

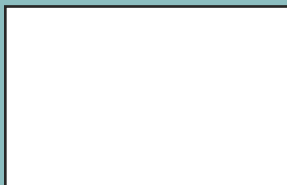
