Dear fellow parishioners,

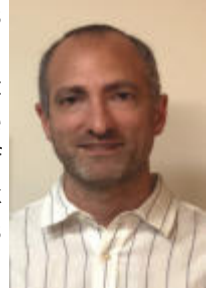
I write to you on the heels of the end of our fiscal year. I often like to look back on our past year and reflect. This past year, however, I look back and think. "What the heck just happened?!" It's starting to feel like words and phrases like "these extraordinary times" are being overused, but this past year was by far the most unique of my life.

At this time last year, we were just a month or two into the start of our car Masses. A Mass in your car was the closest thing to going to church that any of us could experience. Given where we are now, that's a shocking thing to think about. Because of my duties in helping with the car Mass, I really have not been in church too often for Mass until recently. While I would certainly never wish for a pandemic, I will say that our community of Saints JFX did gain some real benefits by living through it. Our first year as a united community came with many challenges that needed to be worked through. These challenges were everywhere -- Mass times, school, YFF, etc. When the pandemic hit about 2/3 of the way through the year, it caused a huge

shift in focus and our two communities came together in such a powerful way. Certainly, we still have work to do but it very much feels like we have turned the corner on the most difficult parts of merging. I so appreciate the good work this community can accomplish united as one.



Lastly, I would be remiss if I didn't at least talk a little bit about our finances. While this past year was difficult in so many ways, I am grateful that we made most of our financial goals for the year and made significant headway in stabilizing our finances. While we still have some work to do, our interim report distributed a few weeks ago really highlights our successes despite the pandemic.

I am grateful for all those that have shared their time, talent, and treasure. Speaking of treasure, I would like to invite you to consider increasing your contribution to our parish. 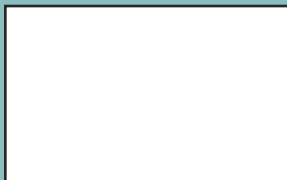
