



Dear Friends,

Today we hear the beginnings of Jesus' "Bread of Life" discourse. During the year of Saint Mark's Gospel, the organizers of the three-year Lectionary fill some of our summer Sundays with these beautiful words of Jesus from Saint John's Gospel.

Over the next few Sundays (except for August 15, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which falls on a Sunday this year) we will hear from Saint John. Jesus will repeatedly remind his listeners, and us, who he is, why he came and what he promises. It is summed up in a few sentences from the Gospel passages this week and next. The words remind me of the importance of regular reception of the Eucharist. In today's Gospel Jesus says, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Next week we will hear him say, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The technology that came as a blessing during the pandemic, allowing us to participate in the Mass from the comfort and safety of our homes, provides much, but lacks something very important. Spiritual Communion, efficacious when necessary, and as great as it is, lacks the actual reception of the bread of life. We are encouraged by the Lord himself to eat His flesh and drink His blood so that we will live forever. The food He gives strengthens us so that we can live in this world as His disciples and, in the next, be happy with Him forever.

So many people have commented to me about the fact that they love our YouTube Masses or watching the Cardinal on TV on Sundays. While I am glad that those media have worked well during the height of the pandemic, those that don't make it to church miss receiving the Lord himself in the Eucharist. Catholic teaching reminds us that the Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life and that attending Sunday Mass as a unified community is the most important thing we can do each week as Catholics. Belief in the real presence urges us to commit to that most important Catholic activity.

Certainly, there are some whose health prevents them from gathering in crowds or to coming to Mass at all. The technological blessing of the pandemic will continue to provide for people in those needs, and our ministers of care, Father Ryan or I will be happy to bring the Eucharist to those who are unable to attend Mass because of health reasons. But I urge those who are healthy and able to come to Mass each Sunday, and even more often if possible.

I think these words of Jesus in the "Bread of Life Discourse" come to us at a perfect time. As the retailers promote their back-to-school specials, the month of August provides a great time to think about educating our young people. Our schools and Youth Faith Formation program seek to make young disciples of the children entrusted to our care. As we go back to school, I encourage all to come back to Mass. Last Sunday's

9:30 am Mass was abuzz with joy. We celebrate six Sunday Masses in our Parish. My dream is to fill each Mass to capacity with parents and children, with the young and the old.

We partner with the parents in the formation of the kids. I plead with parents to share the message Jesus gives in these weeks from Saint John's Gospel with the children God has given you. Please bring your children to church. Encourage them to receive our Lord as often as possible. Commit to regular Sunday Mass attendance. The formation and school programs supplement family faith practices; they do not replace them. The best family faith practice includes receiving our Lord in the Eucharist every Sunday. Jesus tells us so. When we receive the Eucharist, we have strength for the journey.


We have a beautiful statue of the Holy Family, recently restored and repaired, gracing the southeast corner of the SFX parking lot. I thank the Phillips family for their support and encouragement as we moved the statue from its not so graceful temporary location to its prominence on our property.

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph will greet the students entering the buildings at Ninth and Linden. I pray that the statue inspires students and their families to live as the Holy Family did, conforming to God's will and growing in wisdom, age and grace.

I am in Mexico City this weekend for a Baptism. I visited the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe and I prayed special prayers to Our Lady there for the intentions of the wonderful people of Saints JFX.


