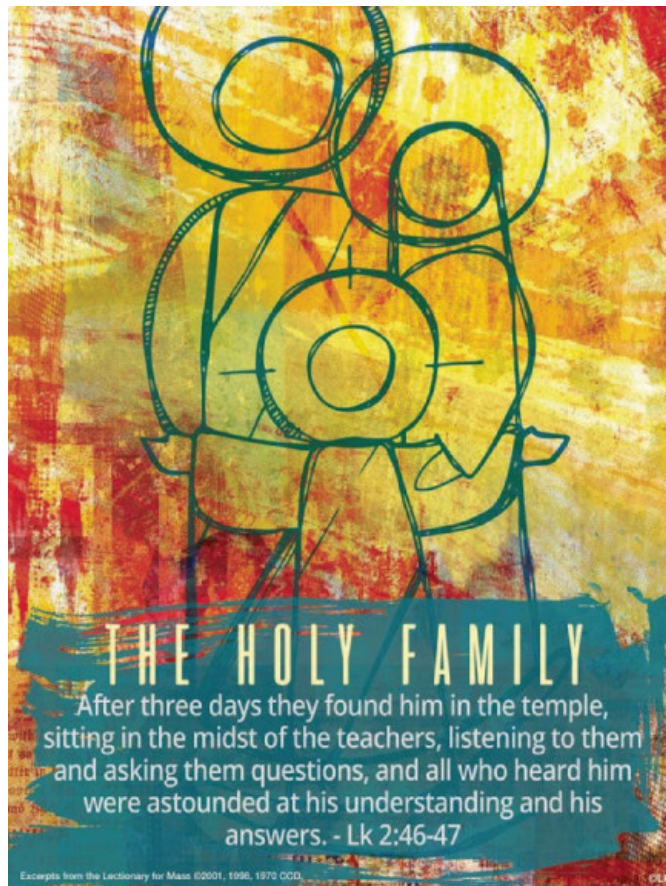

Dear Friends,

Merry Christmas! Today the Church Universal celebrates the Feast of *The Holy Family*. Jesus, whose birth we just celebrated, and his parents, Mary and Joseph, who endured much difficulty and made countless sacrifices to bring the Savior to the world and accomplish the will of God, give us great examples of steadfastness, courage, faith, and love. Today, more than ever, we need to look to the Holy Family as we establish and build our families. Family life has taken a beating in our generation. Now more than ever, we need to renew our unwavering recognition of the dignity of family life.

As we celebrate the Church's feast of the Holy Family, I pause and thank God for my own. I have experienced more than ever the fruits of the labors of my awesome parents as my eight brothers and sisters rallied to help one another – and others – during a difficult and unusual year for many.

Shortly after the death of my father in 2012, countless well-intended people offered the same strange words of condolence. "You're orphans now," they would say to me. At first, I was put off by the comment. As I reflect on it now, I can confidently say, "No we are not!" We have each other. We had great parents who provided for us. We have 28 nieces and nephews. We have the traditions and the customs our parents passed down to us. And we have our faith, a faith that tells us that our God will not leave us orphans. And we (the Watts Family and the Saints JFX family!) are still called to live as the Holy Family, in faith, hope and love.

Those convened at the Second Vatican Council 50 years ago further recognized the dignity of the family by declaring that families were genuinely "Church." The Council restored the ancient concept of "domestic church" as it declared: "In what might be regarded as the domestic church, the parents are to be the first preachers of the faith for their children by word and example" (Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, *Lumen Gentium*, #11).

The early Church began in house churches, where families were the heart of the communities and from which ministers were first called to use their personal gifts to serve the needs of the larger community. The family is the most intimate experience of Church, the place where love, forgiveness, and trust should first be encountered. This is the family Church, whose members are called to embody Christ in everyday life.

We need to take a serious look at how we live as a domestic church in our families. Repeatedly, I remind parents, and the liturgy of Baptism does the same, that they are the first teachers of their children in the ways of the faith. We pray in the liturgy of baptism that the parents be the best of teachers, bearing witness to the faith by what they say and do.



These weeks we often see people in church whom we haven't seen here regularly. I encourage you to make these visitors feel welcome. On this Feast of the Holy Family, my personal prayer is that more and more Catholic families will return to the Church and feel welcomed and needed. I pray that families will take seriously the promises they make when they bring their children for baptism and bring them up in the practice of the faith. I pray that if families have been wounded by the actions of one member of the Church, they will seek healing and reconciliation. I pray that Saints JFX families will commit to frequent participation in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist and enjoy fully the grace they offer.


If all the families of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier commit to full participation in and support the life of this great parish family, our potential will know no bounds. The brightness of the Christmas lights all over Wilmette will not even compare to the bright light we can offer to our community. Our light, our hope and our love will warm and brighten the cold dark Chicago winter days.

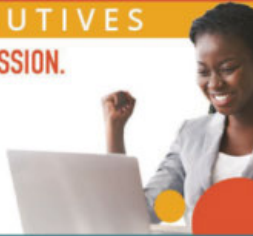

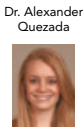
