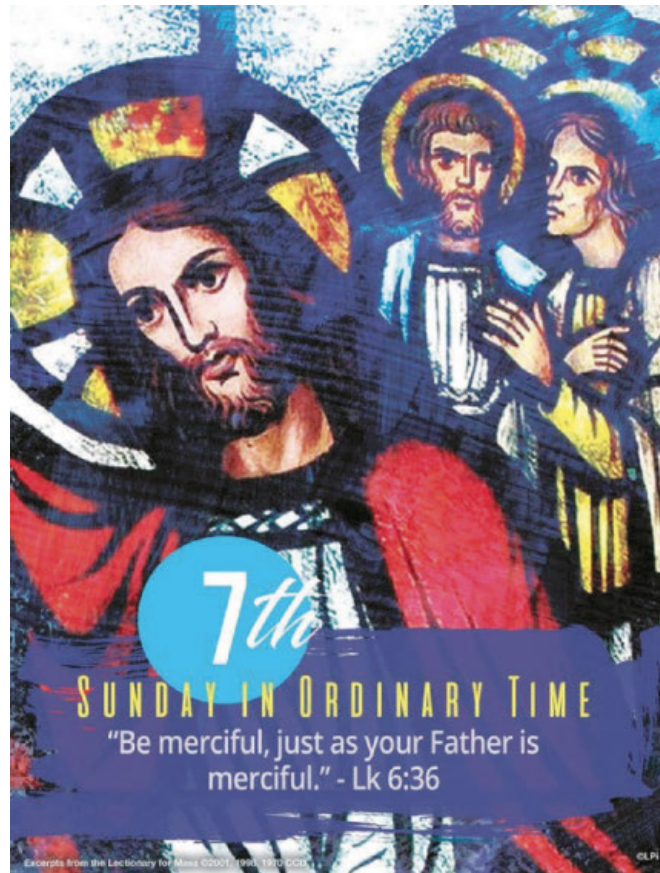

Dear Friends,

If the pandemic has taught me anything, it is to expect the unexpected.

At times, the unexpected has presented itself through seemingly insurmountable challenges. *How will we navigate the sea of Covid compliance required by authorities while also teaching and leading and performing our 'normal' day jobs? How will we respond to expressions of anger and fear when the solutions simply can't meet everyone's different needs?* Other times, the unexpected has arrived in the form of a gift. *Unprompted and authentic acts of kindness. Unimaginable depths of generosity from parent volunteers. Teachers and school nurses who stretched and overextended themselves to ensure our students' safety.*

Some of the greatest gifts I have received, without a doubt, are the lessons I have learned from our students.

I have been an educator for over 30 years, and in classrooms since the moment I first graduated from college. I was fairly confident that I had experienced pretty much anything life as an educator might throw my way. This all changed when March 13, 2020 stopped us in our tracks. What we thought would be an unprecedented two week pause to school morphed into two years of rethinking how we teach, learn, love, and support one another through the most unique of circumstances. Covid threw us adults all for a loop! But through it all, our children modeled how we should respond to the unexpected.

Our children are resilient. They have repeatedly shown us how they are capable of facing adversity head-on. Their ability to adapt has been inspiring! They navigated Zoom like pros. They learned and laughed from afar. But when we shared that students would need to wear masks all day to return in person, I worried... a lot. *Could they do it? Were we asking too much?*

On our first day back in person, an 8th grader shared, "If this is what I have to do so that I can be back in school, then I'll do it." Students ate outside in tents, were confined to rigid cohorts, and missed out on time with dear friends across other homerooms. They learned to support classmates in quarantine, because being in quarantine can be isolating and hard. Important lessons about loneliness and empathy emerged from some of these moments. The way our students reached out and supported one another through trying times was a critical reminder that *love is at the core of all that we do* here at school.

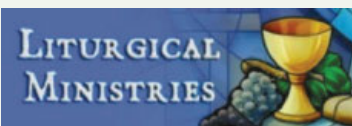


Our children have taught me that flexibility and adaptability are cornerstones to overcoming adversity. That a good belly laugh over something truly silly can be the best medicine for a day full of challenges. That it's OK for an adult to admit to a child that they are having a hard day. That sometimes you simply show up and put one foot in front of the other.

I am truly grateful to our students for the ways they have risen to the occasion over TWO years that turned all we knew upside down. Despite challenges, disappointments and setbacks, they taught us how to adapt. They also modeled new ways to lean on our faith that can push us forward. I knew we were going to be OK when a student shared with me the need to tackle life's challenges through a lens of faith. "That's what Jesus had to do when his life had hard moments, too."

From the Loft

The Communion aria heard at the 5:00pm and 9:30am SFX Mass this weekend is "Domine Deus, Agnus Dei" from Antonio Vivaldi's *Gloria*, RV 588. While Vivaldi composed at least three settings of the Gloria, only two are known to survive. The composer's *Gloria* RV 589 is one of his most familiar and performed works while his other surviving setting sung today, *Gloria* RV 588, is rarely heard. The movement "Domine Deus, Agnus Dei" is scored for soprano, obligato violin, and continuo.

This week the Parish Choir returns to the St. Joseph loft at 10:30am Mass. The Offertory song is a wonderful Gospel anthem, "Order My Steps", by Glenn Burleigh. His gospel songs and spiritual arrangements are among the most popular in the country. This song was awarded the Gospel Song of the Year in 1994 and was featured by the Brooklyn Tabernacle Choir in 1996. "Order my steps, teach me Your will. While You are working, help me be still."

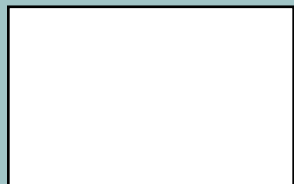

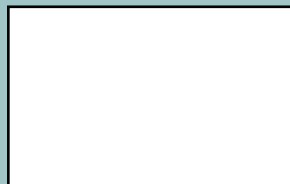
