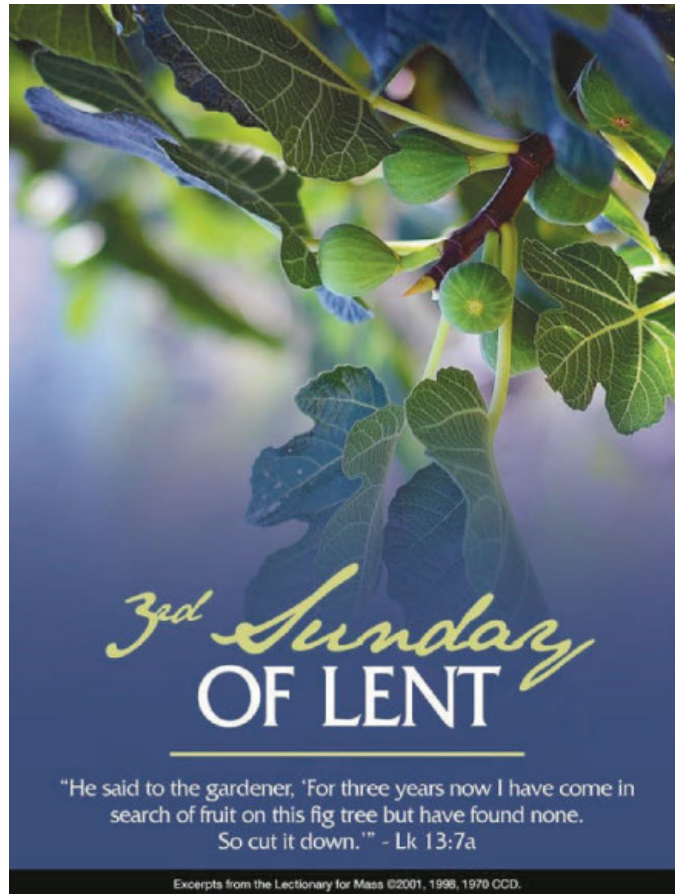

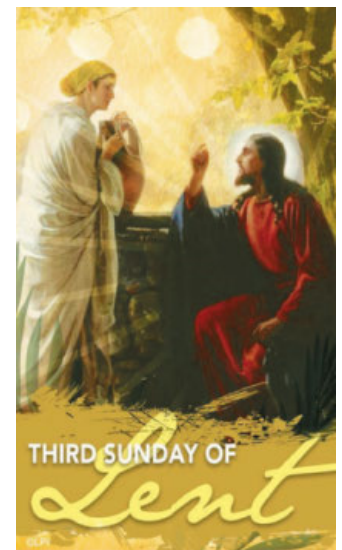

Dear Friends,

Today's readings continue a Lenten theme of repentance and God's patience with us when we seek forgiveness.

Here I am! Each of us has been on the receiving end of this cry from someone we know closely, someone we trust and look forward to seeing. This call anticipates the joy of a reunion, an encounter with somebody we have longed to see. It's a welcoming, an experience that makes us feel good about ourselves.

Though we may not hear God's voice in the spectacular manner of a burning bush that isn't consuming itself as Moses encountered, God is always calling, waiting patiently for us to accept His welcome. In the first reading today, God has heard the cry of his chosen people exiled in Egypt. Enslaved and enduring a harsh existence, God has heard their pleas for help. Moses will now shepherd the chosen people to the land God has promised, the Promised Land.

What are those travails of life that we wish to be released from? What are the attachments, the distractions that we slavishly follow that separate us from our relationship with God? It's for these sins that we ask God's forgiveness. Please bring us to our land of milk and honey by accepting what you ask of us, just as Moses did.

We can be confident in God's forgiveness, for we hear in the responsorial psalm "Merciful and gracious is the Lord, slow to anger and abounding in kindness." Mercy – the act of forgiving us our sins if we are truly repentant -- is the gift God freely gives us when we seek it. The challenge is getting out of our way --swallowing our pride and submitting to a higher power. We hold back and discourage ourselves. A favorite thought about this comes from St. Ignatius who reminds us that discouragement does not come from God but our own, disordered thinking.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is emphatic about repentance. But he doesn't leave it here, using a parable of a sickly fig tree as an example of God's patience and mercy.

Some background about a fig tree will help our understanding of the parable. The fig tree – much like early Christianity – had its origins in the Middle East. Over time, the tree was actively propagated throughout the Mediterranean basin. The fig, the fruit it produces, is a source of several rich nutrients prized for nutritional value. It is a hardy plant that can thrive amid harsh growing conditions. Its survival is heavily dependent on soil that is cultivated – opened – to make the most of the sporadic rainfall in the arid lands it inhabits. It requires this personal care and occasional fertilization to flower and produce life-sustaining fruit.

A particular fig tree in an orchard has not yielded any fruit in three years. The owner of the orchard, expressing frustration with the tree, tells the gardener to cut it down.

The gardener asks the owner for the opportunity to "...cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future." The gardener's patience is God's patience with us – his abounding kindness for us. Our spiritual life requires cultivation – to be opened and fertilized with God's graces and mercy. The tools for this include an active prayer life and participating in the Sacraments given us: Reconciliation and the Holy Eucharist.

These actions will make us, metaphorically, a fig tree that can sustain itself because it is well established with roots deep into the ground. Our tree will bear the fruits that not only sustain us but those around us, yearning for what we can offer. For all are the children of God.

Today's readings encourage us to shout back: "Here I am!" while running to the embrace of a dear friend.
