Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day! Happy Good Shepherd Sunday! How wonderful it is to celebrate these two days together. As we celebrate and remember the Lord's reminder of his closeness to us and our call to be close to one another, we remember our mothers who remind us of that closeness. My own mother used to tell me that every day is Mother's Day, that we are called to thank God for and show respect to our mothers every day of our lives because, for the most part, mothers have responded to God's call to love and to serve.

My mother's own mother died when my mother was only 18 months old, in childbirth. My mother died, as many of you know when she was only 50 and I was 18 years old. She packed a lot of mothering into the 24 years and nine children that came during those years. I do thank God for her. She lived the spirit of evangelization, the New Evangelization, as we call it today. She lived the spirit of the Gospel command, as, I'm sure, do many mothers. She heard the voice of the Good Shepherd and followed him with her life.

This week I asked several people – mothers, fathers, sons, and daughters, young and old – two questions: “What do mothers do? and “Why are you grateful for your mother?” I compiled the answers. Mothers “*have kids, care for their children, love their children, let us keep things they didn't want us to have, take care of their babies, keep you safe, love, cook, take care of you, everything...*” We are grateful for our mothers because mothers “*love us so much, brought us into this world, dedicate their time to help us, help us with the toughest questions, are there for us always and will never abandon us no matter what, are our best friends, are everything fun in the world, send us to great schools, bring us into our faith, and leave a great legacy, and we love them!*”

The Gospel on this Good Shepherd Sunday stresses the importance of the relationship with the sheep and the shepherd. Nine years ago, Pope Francis focused on this relationship in his famous “smell of the sheep” talk to the clergy and the faithful. I share some of his words here.

This I ask you: be shepherds, with the “odor of the sheep”, make it real, as shepherds among your flock, fishers of men... It is not a bad thing that reality itself forces us to “put out into the deep”, where what we are by grace is clearly seen as pure grace, out into the deep of the contemporary world, where the only thing that counts is “unction” – not function – and the nets which overflow with fish are those cast solely in the name of the One in whom we have put our trust: Jesus.

Dear lay faithful, be close to your priests with affection and with your prayers, that they may always be shepherds according to God's heart.

Dear priests, may God the Father renew in us the Spirit of holiness with whom we have been anointed. May he renew his Spirit in our hearts that this anointing may spread to everyone, even to those “outskirts” where our faithful people most look for it and most appreciate it. May our people sense that we are the Lord's disciples; may they feel that their names are written upon our priestly vestments and that we seek no other identity; and may they receive through our words and deeds the oil of gladness which Jesus, the Anointed One, came to bring us. Amen.

Those good words for the priests of the Church provide inspiration for all who answer the call to missionary discipleship. We can all put out into the deep. We all are called to go to the outskirts. We all have a mandate, by virtue of our Baptism, to evangelize, to bring good news, to be close to one another and to share God's love. I thank God, that my mother answered that call and that because of her (and my father), my family experiences to this day the richness of our faith.

I thank the mothers who heed this call, who listen to the voice of the Shepherd and who encourage their children to do the same. I see so many faithful moms at church each Sunday with their children. They realize that the greatest gift that they can give their children is the gift of a strong relationship with the Good Shepherd, making Sunday Mass a priority in the life of the family. I believe that these mothers will reap the benefits of their faithfulness.
