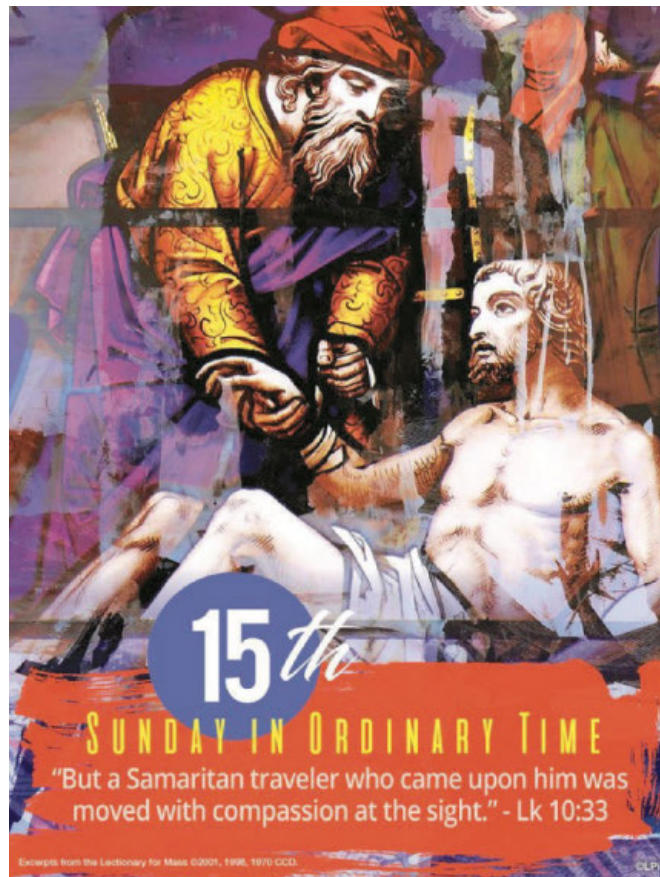

Dear Friends,

***Forgive us, Lord, our indifference!*** The words of Pope Francis, uttered nearly ten years ago when he visited Lampedusa, a sight of an immigration tragedy, shake me. I've been thinking a lot about these words this week, after the horrific situation in Highland Park. On Monday night, Father Marty O'Donovan preached a moving homily to those gathered in Saint Joseph Church, to pray for peace and healing. He told us to be like the good thief, Dismas, and find our voice, and to use our voice to defend all life, the unborn and the born. His words prompt me to write this.

An unspeakable tragedy happened Monday. While many of us were at the beach, celebrating with family and friends, shots rang out - fewer than ten miles from this parish. Seven people perished, including the mother and father of a two-year-old toddler, who was found wandering alone amidst the chaos of the aftermath of the shooting. Monday evening, I had the tragic honor of anointing a dying victim and accompanying his family in their sorrow. All of it fills my heart and head as I write this.

A young man, with prior encounters with the police, and with a history of violence, was able to legally purchase five guns, including a high-powered assault rifle.

Our gun laws allow this. He purchased, we are told, the guns right here in our area. As those called to defend life, we have an obligation to confront the evil of accessibility of assault rifles. We must act. We must use our voices to counter the loud voices of the gun lobby. We must do our part to put an end to the plague of gun violence, which creeps closer and closer to our doors.

Cardinal Cupich spoke out after the tragedy in Highland Park. The Cardinal said, as part of his official statement, *"Whatever one makes of the right to bear arms, there is plenty of room for prudential judgment in interpreting the Second Amendment so as to enact serious, broadly popular gun-safety measures. The Senate finally passed a significant, yet modest, gun-safety bill last month. But clearly more must be done."*

*The right to bear arms does not eclipse the right to life, or the right of all Americans to go about their lives free of the fear that they might be shredded by bullets at any*

*moment. Gun violence is a life issue. We must continue to pray that all our officials, elected and unelected alike, will redouble their commitment to keeping safe the people they have sworn to serve."*



In a telegram to Cardinal Cupich, Cardinal Parolin, the Vatican Secretary of State, wrote, *"His Holiness Pope Francis was deeply saddened to learn of the senseless shooting that took place in Highland Park and he asks that you convey his spiritual closeness to all affected by this attack. His Holiness joins the entire community in praying that Almighty God will grant eternal rest to the dead and healing and consolation to the injured and bereaved. With unwavering faith that the grace of God is able to convert even the hardest of hearts, making it possible to depart from evil and do good, Pope Francis prays that every member of society will reject violence in all of its forms and respect life in all of its stages. As pledge of strength and peace in the Lord, the Holy Father Sends his blessing."*

The story of the Good Samaritan - and the actions of the first responders, the medical teams, and even the bystanders along the parade route on Monday - should really make us think about our own lives, and how we respond to the world around us. Every time I hear the story of the goodness, generosity, charity and mercy of the foreigner, and the negligence of the others, *especially the priest*, I cringe. I ask myself, and I share the question with you, "How are *you* standing for what is right and just? What do *you* do to help those in need? How are *you* bringing the mercy of God to our broken world?"

Too often, when help is needed, we act like the Levite and the priest; we turn our heads or close our ears to the cries for help. Today, we need to do more than pray. We must act to end violence of all sorts, to create a culture that respects life from conception to natural death.

## SHARING OUR GIFTS INITIATIVE

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### WHAT IS THE SHARING OUR GIFTS INITIATIVE?

The Sharing Our Gifts Initiative relies on the historic sharing parish partnership between Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish and St. Thomas of Canterbury School. A group of generous parishioners at SJFX has created a 1:1 matching gift to clear the waitlist of students at St. Thomas in line for a tax credit scholarship.

#### WHAT IS A TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP?

Under Illinois' Invest in Kids Act, families seeking K-12 education options at a private school can apply for a need-based scholarship to the school of their choice. Scholarships are funded by generous individuals who make a gift to the school of their choice and in turn are eligible to earn a 75% state tax credit.

#### HOW CAN I MAKE MY GIFT?

Gifts will be matched until October 30, 2022, or when matching funds are depleted.

#### CAN NON-PARISHIONERS PARTICIPATE IN THE MATCH?

Yes, all members of the community who are willing to extend their generosity can participate.

#### WHAT IS THE BEST WAY TO MAKE SURE MY GIFT QUALIFIES FOR THE MATCH? DO I HAVE TO SEND MY GIFT THROUGH EMPOWER ILLINOIS?

For your gift to qualify for the match, your donation must be made through Empower Illinois and designated to St. Thomas of Canterbury School.
