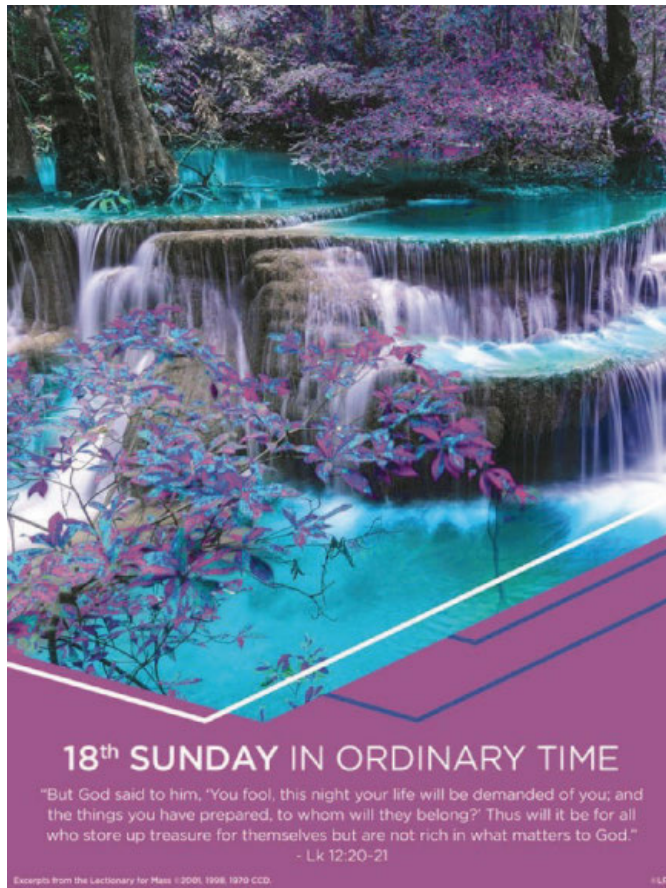

Dear Friends,

Jesus was a philanthropist.

As we endure another month of precarious economic times, the Universal Church provides us with food for thought in our Scripture readings for the day. Our scriptures tell us that accumulation of material goods and money to buy them really is a waste of time and that we really should be storing up treasure in heaven. Over the past few years, we have heard of those who were so attracted to material riches that they would do anything, legal or illegal, to amass more and more.

Over the past 57 years, I have heard many sayings about the foolishness of depending on material wealth for happiness; most of them came from my mother. "You can't take it with you." "There are no pockets in shrouds." And recently, "There are no U-Hauls behind hearses."

But we still collect money and stuff. We still place priority on personal wealth. We still worry about how much money we have in our personal bank accounts. We still store up treasure for ourselves. For what? Our Lord tells us that we need to be rich in what matters to God. We need to focus on doing God's will. We need to not be obsessed with accumulating money and things but focus on sharing what we have.

"Vanity of Vanities..." In the book of Ecclesiastes, written centuries and centuries ago, the wise teacher reminds his students and us that it is such a waste to spend all our talents and time accumulating wealth that we will ultimately not be able to use. In this, Qoheleth says modern day workaholics allow the wrong priorities to get in the way of a healthy, life-giving relationship with our God. Toil and anxiety result.

Today's Scriptures invite us to reevaluate our priorities. On what are we spending our time? On what are we spending our energies? To what are we giving our lives? What are we seeking?

Saint Paul exhorts us to seek what is above. Seek the kingdom of God. When we seek what is above, when we seek the kingdom of God, everything else falls in place. When we waste our energies seeking material gains solely for the sake of material gains, we lose. We lose relationships; we lose our way; we even risk losing our God. Material wealth, as we have seen over the past 15 months in this tumultuous economy, is evasive. Relying on money will surely disappoint.

What does all that say to us today?

To me, the Scriptures for this Sunday call for an examination of my life, priorities, philanthropy, and spending. The readings call me to review my relationships and examine my work habits. They urge me to remember that all that I have is a gift from God and that if I am really seeking what is above; I need to share what I have more willingly, less selfishly, and without counting the cost.

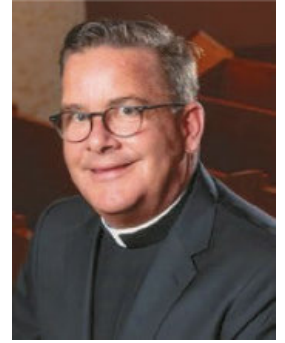
I invite you to consider your spending this week. What are you doing with the wages God allows you to earn? Many people I know spend more at Starbucks than they give to the church each week. Are you storing up treasure for yourself? Jesus says to you if you are, "Be careful!" Sometimes people aren't giving to the parish because they forget their check or envelope at home, or they forgot to bring cash to church. I use givecentral.org to make my donations to the parish. I would be the one forgetting the check or cash to be sure.

When I use givecentral.org, I make a thoughtful, prayerful gift. I budget my philanthropy as I budget everything else. It is not an afterthought. I invite you to do the same. It will help you and will help the parish. Consider too, increasing your gift. If EVERYONE increased their gift by just 10% our financial situation would greatly improve. And it would be good for your soul. Jesus was a philanthropist. We can be too.
