Dear Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier family,

I've recently returned from my thirteenth pilgrimage to Lourdes, France with Father Wayne and 32 pilgrims. When we arrived in Lourdes, I was not shocked to see thousands of believers from all around the world processing at the nightly Rosary. One of the reasons I love Lourdes so much is the universality of our Church and the unity of all the people. Everyone seems to be "awake".

In the gospel today we hear Jesus say to his disciples "Stay awake!". Often at home I can get caught up in this world and the distractions it creates away from our God. We can all try harder to be awake every day and help our fellow community members to stay awake. We can do this by going to Mass every Sunday, welcoming all members of our community into our lives and the lives of our church, and by going out and doing the good work Jesus teaches us in the gospel.

My maternal grandparents were a great influence on my life, and I try to remember all that they taught me through their words and their actions. They were "awake"! They not only practiced their faith daily by going to Mass, but they lived it by giving without counting the cost. They did not let the woes of this world distract them from what they believed in, they always welcomed the stranger, and they always turned to God.

I notice that many of my peers are not "awake" until something happens that forces them to turn to our God. I am not saying I am perfect; I do it too. I see that often people turn to Him when they are in troubled times, or they are getting married or having a child baptized. Or they want their kids to get a Catholic education, but they do not do the work to teach the values of our church or go to Mass.

I feel fortunate that after college I was able to drive my grandmother to daily Mass. My uncle asked if I would chauffeur her because she was having trouble driving and my grandfather had just passed. Every day, when I drove her, I learned something new. It was often just by being with her that I learned something, she did not even need to talk.

One of the things I remember most was my grandmother would be waiting outside when I came to pick her up. I arrived with plenty of time to get her to 6:15am Rosary before Mass. She was so excited to get to her community and participate and receive the Eucharist. She taught me the importance of being "awake" and ready!



Another thing I remember distinctly during those rides was talking to her about the Carmelite nuns, an order of cloistered nuns. I questioned their lifestyle and my grandmother quickly chirped back at me with a strong faith filled answer. She said that the nuns gave up their lives to God so that they could pray for me.

Whenever I feel defeated or upset, I think of my grandparents' faith. Their willingness to give it all to God, to make sure that God was the center of their lives and the reason they got up. They did not let concerts, sports, trips, etc. get in the way of Sunday Mass. They did not let people deter or distract them from what was right and just! They welcomed all with open arms and showed them by example. They made all feel so part of their lives by goodness and generosity. They were fun and loved life and they were awake, knowing the Son of Man would come!

I am grateful for our community at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier, and I hope we will continue to be awake and welcome all, so that when the Son of Man comes, we are ready!

We welcome Sr. Jackie Atabong to Saints JFX this weekend. Sr. Jackie will be speaking at our Masses on behalf of the Sisters of St. Therese in Cameroon, Africa, through the Global Mission Office of the Archdiocese of Chicago.

The Congregation of the Sisters of St. Therese is a Diocesan Congregation of religious women in Cameroon, Africa, founded on January 29, 1963 to serve the needs of the church and to raise the dignity of the local woman. We are involved in education, health care and socio-pastoral activities. We are engaged in social justice and work with marginalized persons in the prisons, street children, battered women and internally displaced persons.

Following a 6-year ongoing political upheaval in the country, during which whole villages were raised to dust, many people killed, hundreds of thousands have been displaced and schools have been shut down in the affected areas. Many girls, women and children are stranded in the streets and forced into prostitution. In response to this new reality, the sisters have opened a shelter in a nearby city, where they provide a safe haven for some of the victims (women and children). We provide rehabilitation, safety, security, mental health care, education, and skills training. We currently house the girls in a very small apartment, but have purchased land to construct a bigger shelter and staff house. We would deeply appreciate your support to continue to provide for the girls, women and children. Thank you.

### School Bells are Ringing at St. Thomas of Canterbury

We are about to start our new school term with a very full house of students. Due to the inclusion of students from St Mary of the Lake and the national teacher shortage we have very large class sizes. We've had several teachers resign in August and we are not able to replace them. Volunteers are needed more than ever!

#### Volunteer jobs:

- Work with upper grade teachers and students to carefully edit essays. One on one is the best way for students to improve their writing skills.
- Work with a specific classroom teacher and be available for a designated time every week to work with individual students or with small groups.
- Work with students in upper grades in math. Our program covers pre-algebra, algebra and geometry. Students who are not in the advanced track are often in need of support.
- Work with newly arrived students who do not speak English.

#### Qualifications:

- Be able to commit to a regular schedule.
- Submit all requirements for school personnel/volunteers to the Archdiocese (we have a packet).
- Let us know your preferences (little kids, math, etc.)
