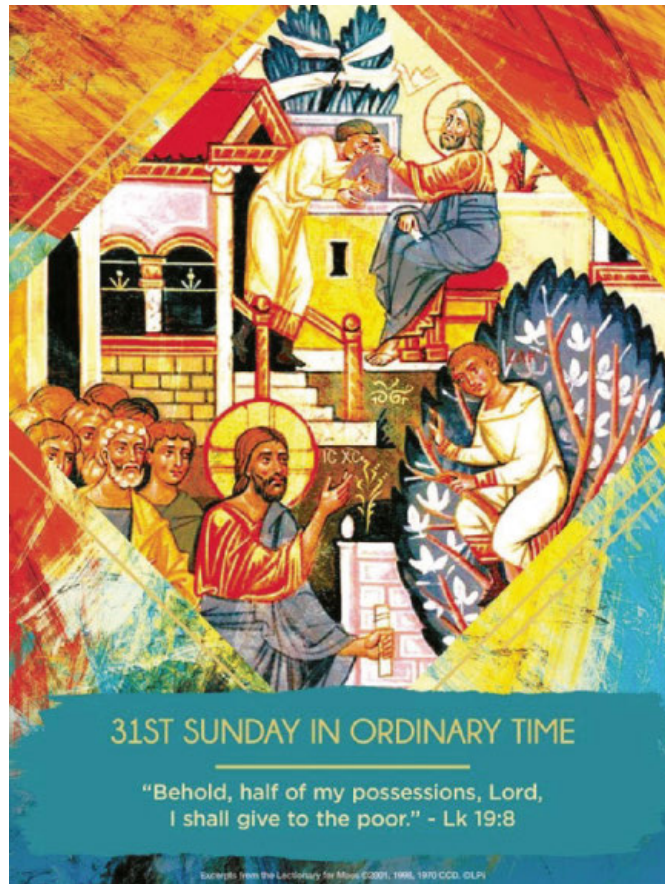

Dear Friends,

Ever since I was a three and a half foot tall kindergarten student I have always loved the Zacchaeus story. We even sang a song about him in my class. The song, as the Gospel itself does, featured a few comments about his height. I could relate! Zacchaeus' eagerness to encounter, and enter into relationship with the Lord inspires me. He just wanted to see him, to know him, to please him. He went to the extreme of climbing the tree just to get a glimpse of the passing Lord. Perhaps he was aware of his own smallness. Jesus took notice.

Jesus invites us to share in his intimate relationship with the Father. I wonder how eager we are to encounter the Lord. Is our personal encounter with the Lord a priority in our lives? To what extremes will we go to see him, know him, and please him? Are we too hurried to take the time to recognize him in our midst? When we seek him, we will find him and, as he did with Zacchaeus, Jesus will notice us. He will invite himself into our hearts, our homes and will transform us with his love. Take the time. Make the effort. Seek out Jesus. And allow him to find you.

I am so pleased at the number of families who are committing to Sunday Mass, a great opportunity to encounter the Lord. **Our new 4:45 Sunday afternoon Mass seems to be serving the community well.** It has, though, placed a bit of a burden on the staff. We really need people to step up and serve at that (and other) Mass. We need committed ministers. Eucharistic ministers, lectors, ushers... I've been told that we have a very large list of ministers, but the number of those *actually* signing up via the online application are significantly fewer. If you have been trained and commissioned as a liturgical minister, please sign up. We need you, at the 4:45 Sunday Mass - and at all the rest of them. There was a time when we had a great rotation of ministers willing to serve. Although many are still on the list, fewer and fewer are signing up to serve. This is your parish. The priests and staff can do our part; but we count on you to do yours too.

During the month of November, as we end our liturgical year and prepare to begin another, we will examine our stewardship. Next weekend we will distribute our Annual Stewardship Report. Members of the Finance Council will speak at all the Masses, encouraging your stewardship of this great place. We'll invite involvement and active participation in the life of this great parish. When we all work together for the good of the parish, the Archdiocese of Chicago, and the Church Universal, our future will be bright.

That starts with following the example of Zacchaeus. He decided to be an intentional disciple. A personal, intimate relationship with God will lead us to the truth and the truth will set us free. Jesus wants to stay in the "home" of our hearts. Let's open our hearts and let Jesus live in us.



November is also the month that we remember our beloved dead. We faithfully remember them, knowing, as the book of Wisdom tell us "the souls of the just are in the hand of God." Know that those listed in the parish book of the dead will be remembered in all of our Masses this month. If you have names to add to the book, please contact me and I will be sure to add them.

On Tuesday, we celebrate All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have Mass at 6:30am at Saint Francis and 8:30am at Saint Joseph. Wednesday, All Souls Day, we will remember all the faithful departed at our morning Masses and at a special 7:30pm candlelight Mass at Saint Joseph Church, where we will mention by name those members of our community who have died in the last year. The All Soul's Day evening Mass traditionally has offered healing and hope to grieving families. Whether you come because you have lost a loved one or come to support those who have, you will be happy you did.

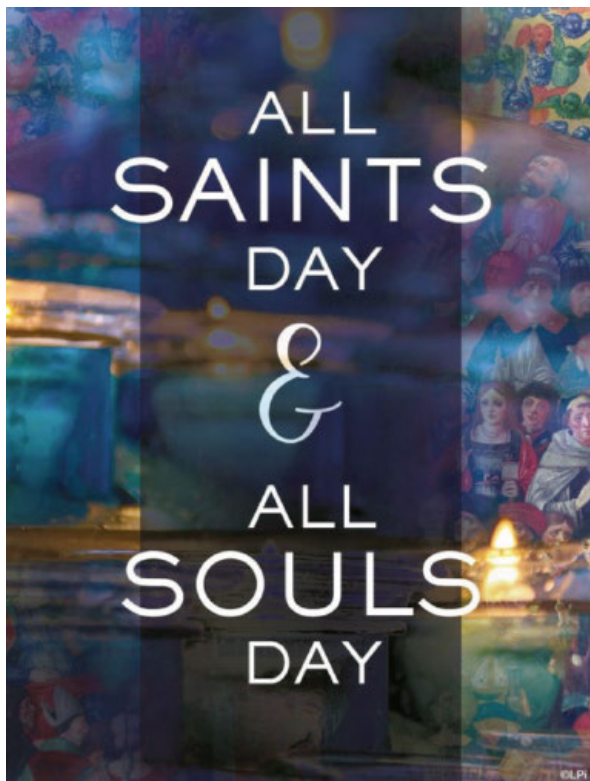

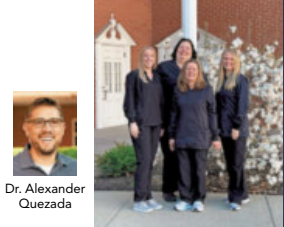

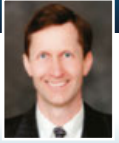
