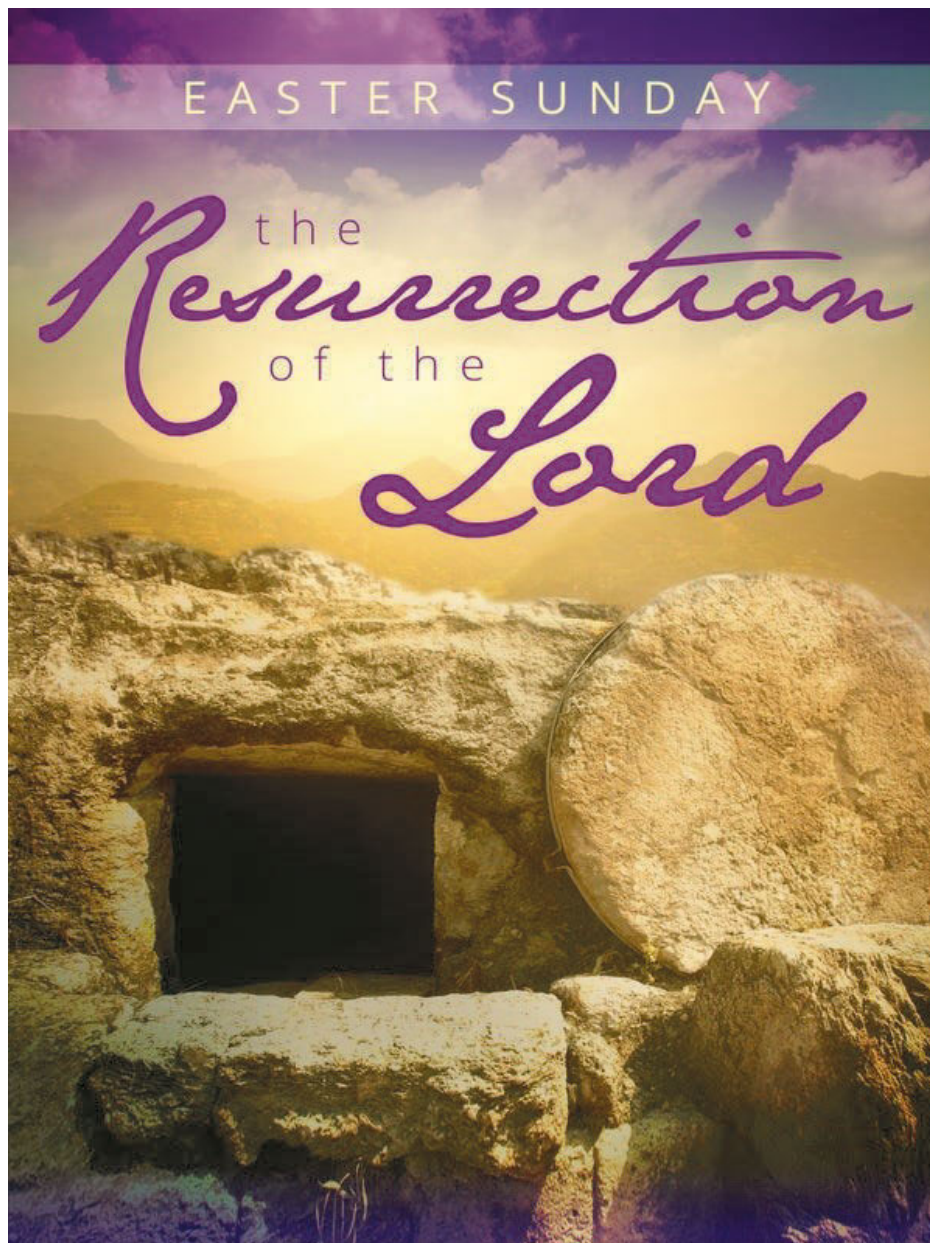

Dear Friends,
Happy Easter to all! Love wins!

Chicago just finished a runoff mayoral election season. In elections, just as in life, there are winners and losers. The competition was fierce. As we finish Holy Week, and begin the fifty-day celebration of Easter, we reflect on the competition between good and evil. Today, we celebrate the culmination of that fierce competition; we rejoice that Christ wins.

At the Easter Vigil, after hearing the seven beautiful accounts from the Hebrew Scriptures of God's hand in Salvation history, we listen to Saint Paul's confident address to the people of Rome. He says clearly, *"If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him."*

The past few days, even weeks, we have witnessed in the Gospels a sense of competition, between good and evil, between life and death, between God's ways and the ways of the world. The competition heightened during the Paschal Triduum. From the Last Supper to the crucifixion, to the tomb, one might think that Jesus was losing the contest, that evil was conquering good. In these difficult socio-economic times, it might be easy to believe that the story ends on Friday. So many people, this year more than ever, are feeling like they are on the losing end, that they really could die, or have died, with Jesus.

The fact remains. In Baptism, we all die with Jesus. We die to original sin; we die to an old way of life. That death offers, as Saint Paul tells us, life. On this Easter weekend we rejoice and sing our long-lost alleluias because of the life offered. At the beginning of the passage from his letter to the Romans, Saint Paul asks, *"Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?"* He goes on to remind them, and us, of God's divine reasoning. *"We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life."* Jesus Wins! So do we. Today, Easter Day, God raises us to new life in Christ, to share in the victory. He calls us to live Easter joy. He grants to us Easter hope. *Joyful hope.* That's what this day offers: Joyful Hope. That's what this world needs. If you are here for the first time this weekend,

please know that you are welcome here. All are welcome at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier. Consider making this parish your spiritual home. The people of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier are truly alive in the love of Christ. Great things happen here. Join us. Become part of the victory. Become part of our parish community. Share your self, your gifts. I promise if you do, you will not be disappointed. We say, "Love wins! And all are welcome!"



Take our Easter gifts of holy water and a magnet for your car. Display proudly your affiliation with this great parish. I see more and more of those magnets on cars around town. Let people know that you are part of this great community, and, if you have the opportunity, invite them to join us.

The beautiful sights and sounds of the season didn't just appear. A lot of hard work went into our beautiful celebrations. Join me in thanking all who raised their hands to help. And consider joining them going forward.

Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is the main consultative body of the parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission.

The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as Stewardship, Hospitality, and Youth Faith Formation. This past year, one of our key accomplishments was the completion of a parish-wide survey.

Terms are 3 years, and the preferred number of members is 12. PPC has in-person meetings on the third Monday of the month at 7:30 pm. Work involves around 5 hours a month.

Finance Council assists the Pastor in discharging his responsibilities in the administration, management, and stewardship of the financial affairs of the parish. The Finance Council works with the Pastor and the Director of Operations in preparing and approving the annual budget, overseeing and approving major capital expenditures, producing and communicating the Annual Report of the Parish Finances to Parishioners as well as reviewing the operating results and providing important guidance in the financial management of the parish.

Meetings are held on the 4th Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to the monthly meeting, council volunteers are asked to work on sub-committees to actively work on Parish finance projects. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Finance Council is between 9 and 12.

The council is open to all parishioners and strives to have a mix of professional backgrounds including, but not limited to, finance, accounting, legal, marketing, consulting, and fundraising from both parish and school individuals across a range of age groups.

The Stewardship Committee works to stimulate Parish life and involvement through a variety of initiatives including coordinating area parties and parish events, welcoming new parishioners, spearheading the annual Ministry Fair, and organizing fundraising efforts when needed. We rely on the creative energy and contributions from a wide range of parishioners from multiple generations and backgrounds and invite you to join us!

Meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of the month. Volunteer opportunities are organized around our subcommittees including Hospitality, Time & Talent, Communications and Treasure. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Stewardship Committee is between 12 and 15. The committee is open to all parishioners.

Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier School Board is an advisory body serving the Pastor and Principal through input rooted in expertise and experience across a range of disciplines including finance, facilities, marketing, technology, academic planning, and development.

The Board is currently accepting applications for 3-year appointments beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year. Meetings are held the first Tuesday of every other month during the school year. Board members should be Saints JFX parishioners, school parents or community members.
