

#### Dear Friends.

Fr. Wayne has given me this opportunity to tell you about the parish's new religious education program which is geared for all members of the family. You have seen information about this throughout the summer in the parish's weekly e-blasts. The program is called "Family of Faith" and its purpose is to involve all members of the family in learning about a specific tenet of our faith together, at whatever level each member can understand. Most of us adults have not had any "formal" religious education since we left school, so there is a lot out there that we have probably forgotten, or maybe did not even learn. Family of Faith presents our beliefs as Catholic Christians so the entire family can learn together, and this learning can take place in the home, incorporated during mealtimes, time spent in the car while driving to activities, etc.

I am so pleased that we have had so many families register for this program – over 180 families! This new method of teaching was introduced in the Archdiocese of Chicago a few years ago. St. Edward Parish on the north side has been using it for 6 years, and we are relying on their positive experience in our "roll out" of this program at SSJFX. Back on September 24, we had a "meet and greet" for those who have registered for the program. It was a very lively (and loud) gathering of families. They were able to pick up their materials and visit with others while the kids had pizza. I was delighted to feel the energy and see the enthusiasm of those present.

I am grateful to Fr. Watts and Fr. Ryan for their willingness to introduce this to our parish and grateful for their guidance and support as we explored the options available to us as we researched different methods of bringing the faith to and enriching the faith in our families.

Our first parent sessions, this past Tuesday, were well attended. The parents asked some great questions about the process and had some terrific ideas about how to accomplish the goal of learning together as a family. We are in this together, and all of us want to be able to raise our children in the faith, giving them the awareness of God's love for us – even before we came to be.

We have a wonderful community of faith, and this program will enhance that faith for all our families. Please reach out to me if you have questions or would like additional information about the program.







Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner, St. Thomas of Canterbury School. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.


