Dear Friends,

The psalmist writes, "Give to the Lord glory and honor." Our Lord clearly says to the naysayers of his day, "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." Guess what. Everything belongs to God! So if we are to repay to God what belongs to God, we owe God all that we are and are that we have. When we hold back from sharing our time, talent, and treasure, we neglect the repayment process.

We end the first reading today with a powerful line from the Prophet Isaiah, speaking to God's beloved on behalf of the Lord himself. "I am the Lord and there is no other, there is no God besides me." In fact, he repeats the assertion just so we are clear, "I am the Lord, there is no other." Though, today, many things vie for lordship in our lives; the distractions, many though they are, can crowd the Lord out. False gods block our truly giving ourselves to the one and only God. Only you and I can reject the false ones and focus on giving all that we have and are to the One who created us, loves us, forgives us, and pursues us.

As we hear the words of the psalmist this weekend, telling us to glorify the Lord by the way we live our lives, and as we listen to Jesus himself tell us to give to God what is God's, I thank the many, many, of you who have generously answered the call to serve. We are the Body of Christ. You are the Body of Christ. Every member of the Body is needed.


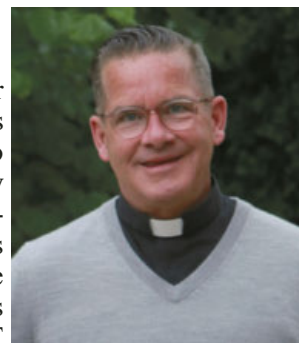
Churches that rely solely on the gifts of the *ordained* ministers to succeed, fail. Long-time parishioners can tell you that pastors come and go. Hopefully as they have come and gone, and I will come and go, while here, we share whatever gifts we have with this community. My prayer is that my ministry here gives the Lord glory and honor. But the community, the faithful parishioner family, provides the stability and is the lifeblood of the parish. When we reflect on repaying to God what is God's, we should look at how we spend our time. Do we give the Lord glory and honor as we spend our free time? What have you offered to give, in the way of talents, to God's Church? Do we live out the works of mercy in the community in which we live?

Our service to God doesn't necessarily have to be done on the campuses of Saints JFX (although we have hundreds of opportunities here), but simply said, it needs to be done. Period. I invite you this week to truly reflect on the honor and glory you give to God, with your attitudes and with your actions. So many of you give God so much glory by the ways you give – and live. I thank God for that.

Every three years, as we hear from the readings in the Church's "Cycle A," two memories come to mind. First, my parents... If they told us once, they told us a thousand times, "God, as gift, grants all that we have and all that we are. Out of gratitude for the gifts you have received, you **MUST** share them." Second, my second-grade teacher, who taught us a song. Fifty years later, I can still sing the song. It said, "Love is like a magic penny. Hold it tight and you won't have any. Lend it, spend it and you'll have so many they'll roll all over the floor!"

God bestows on us the gift of love. God accords us all the blessings – material and spiritual – that we have. Let's commit to sharing them with this community and, as this community, with the world around us. Let's not hold tight to any of our gifts, to our time, talent, *or* treasure. Let's spend them in the act of repaying to God what is God's. Caesar will take care of himself!

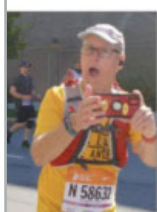
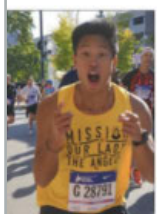
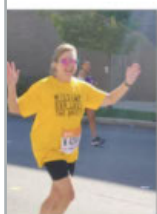
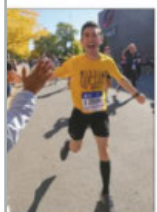
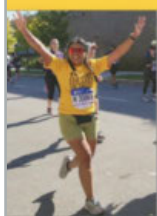


OUR PARISH BOOK OF THE DEAD

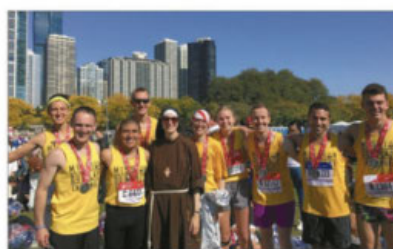

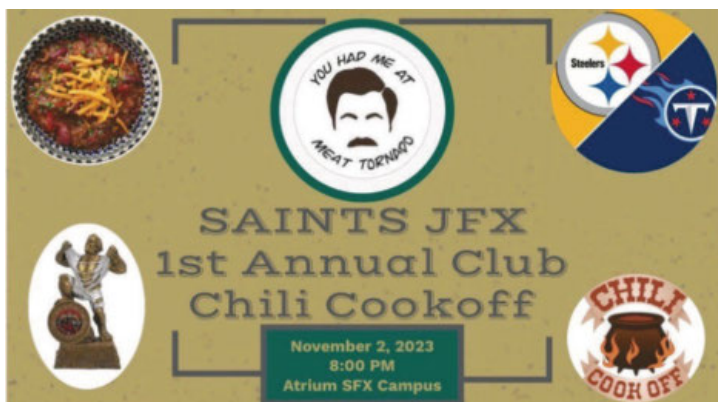
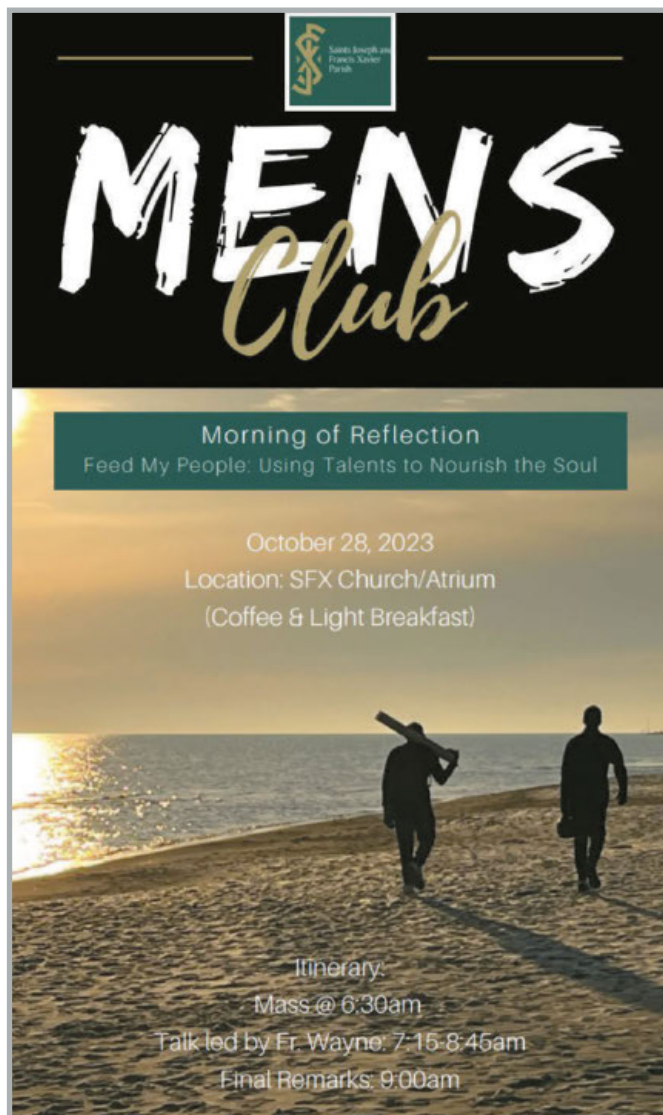

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We, the Catholic bishops of Illinois, write with a sense of urgency. Unless the General Assembly acts to renew the Invest in Kids scholarship program, more than 9,000 children currently relying on this program to attend a non-public school may have their educational path disrupted. Without an extension of the program in Illinois law now, no scholarships will be awarded for the school year that will begin in September 2024. Most of these children will have to leave the school their families determined was their best chance to receive a high-quality education in a safe and wholesome learning environment. This is an injustice that should and can be avoided, but only if the General Assembly acts when it reconvenes on October 24, 2023.

Invest in Kids has proven to be a beacon of hope for thousands of Illinois students and their families. Children receiving Invest in Kids scholarships come from lower-income families who could not otherwise afford tuition at the Catholic or another non-public school that is the best fit for their child. Childhood is a limited time in the life of a human being and primary and secondary education is not something that can be put off to some future date when it is convenient for adults. This is our one chance to offer these Illinois children a good start. Please help keep education options available and a brighter future possible by contacting your state senator and state representative and telling them to continue the Invest in Kids Program.

Since its inception six years ago, Invest in Kids has generated overwhelmingly positive results. Nearly 40,000 scholarships have been awarded to students attending non-public schools across Illinois. Demand for scholarships is very high - for every scholarship granted, three students are turned down due to lack of funds. Contrary to what you may have heard, this is not a voucher program, nor does it take state funds away from the public schools. These scholarships are funded through contributions from donors who receive a tax credit for their donation on their Illinois state income tax.

What can you do to help? Please contact your state senator and state representative to let them know of your support for extending the Invest in Kids tax credit scholarship program in Illinois. We also encourage you to urge your fellow parishioners to do the same. Our collective voice is vital to the continued help for Illinois families. 
