

## St. Vincent de Paul: A Lifeline of Support

- A Wilmette woman struggling with a fractured spine, trying to survive on disability income of \$1,000 a month. Her electricity had been shut off due to lack of payment, so she was unable to do laundry and was living by flashlight. St. Vincent de Paul paid her overdue electric bill and got her lights turned back on. We also collaborated with other agencies who will support her going forward.\*
- A Winnetka middle school student whose immigrant family was unable to provide her with the cost of a lunch on a school field trip. On a previous field trip, she was embarrassed to ask for help and had to skip lunch. St. Vincent de Paul provided her with gift cards so could eat lunch with her fellow students.\*
- A disabled Glenview woman in her 50's who suffers from PTSD, anxiety, and depression. Her Medicaid benefits had been terminated without her knowing it, and she faced mounting bills for her therapy and medications. Forced to decide whether to buy food or pay her medical bills or rent, she feared homelessness. St. Vincent de Paul visited her home, paid one month of rent, utilities, and her psychiatrist's bill, and gave her Jewel gift cards.\*
