



Catholic Charities' Assistance to Asylum Seekers

Catholic Charities has now assisted 11,000 asylum seekers in their resettlement. This means we have directly supported nearly half of the 25,000 individuals who have arrived in Chicago since August 2022.

- A team of 60+ bilingual staff members is responding each day.
- More than 2,800 migrants have joined loved ones in other cities; Funds and eligibility for these transfers are provided and determined by the State of Illinois.
- We have connected 7,800 migrants to long-term housing in Greater Chicago.
- We are partnering with nearly 30 parishes who want to offer financial support and/or direct accompaniment to asylum seekers for several months as they get settled.
- Asylum seekers are obtaining food, clothing and other basic services through Catholic Charities programs and services already established.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we celebrate the birth of Jesus, we also celebrate the birth of our hope. When he came among us as one like us in all things but sin, he lifted us up to new and transformed life. In fact, he opened for us the way to share in the very life of God. One of the prayers of the Mass gives us these words: "...may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity."

The struggles that we face in our personal lives and in our wounded world do not have the last word. We are meant for more. We are meant for full and eternal life. I pray that our celebration of the Lord's birth will remind us of the glory that will carry us beyond the challenges, sometimes truly significant challenges that mark our lives and our world.

We must also remember that the Lord did not just come among us once and long ago. He continues to walk with us as we walk with each other. Our celebrations of the Eucharist remind of that. And he will never abandon his people. He is now and always Emmanuel, our God with us. Our journey is his journey. And this year, having celebrated the first of two synods of the Church, we are especially aware that he accompanies us as we accompany one another.

If you do so, I can assure you that you will know his peace. Then, take what you learn from him to your family, to your workplace, to your community, and to entire world. The gift of Jesus, the Incarnate Word of God, is not something we can hold for ourselves. We are called and destined to share it with others.

As I celebrate the Eucharist, I will remember you and pray that you will have a living sense of the Lord among us, the one who walks with us and draws us forward into the fullness of his life.

Father Chris Manahan entered the Society of Jesus in 1993 at the age of 37 after a 15-year career as a news paper reporter and editor in Minnesota and Iowa. After ordination in 2003 he served two years as a parish priest on the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota; spent a year working with Jesuits in the Philippines and northeast India; served eight years on the staff of the Jesuit Novitiate where men discern whether to profess vows; and, for seven years was director of the Jesuit Retreat House on Lake Winnebago at Oshkosh, WI. Father Manahan currently assists the provincial in caring for Jesuits in the Midwest Province awaiting final vows and for the province's senior Jesuits who are 70 years and older. He currently lives in the Taylor Street Jesuit Community in Chicago.

Medjugorje Presentation - January 11, 2024



Guild 4 of the Saints JFX Women's Club is hosting a talk on Medjugorje on January 11, 2024 to be given by Fr. Ryan. This talk is open to the entire parish and will take place in the Community Room at the St. Joseph campus at 7pm. A brief reception will follow. A Signup Genius will be included in future communications for those who wish to attend.

Medjugorje is a small village in Bosnia and Herzegovina, an ex-Yugoslav country. Since 1981, it has been reported that the Virgin Mary (a white form with a child in her arms) began appearing to a group of six local teenagers (visionaries). The area has

become a place of pilgrimage for millions of people. Currently, three of the visionaries still receive daily apparitions and one of these is given a message from Our Lady for the world on the 25th of each month. The remaining visionaries have yearly apparitions. The Church has determined that the events at Medjugorje require further study to determine whether a supernatural character is present.

Fr. Ryan has conducted two pilgrimages to Medjugorje and will share his experiences with us. We hope you will join us.


