Dear Friends,

Is not man's life on earth a drudgery? When shall I see happiness again?

As I read and reread those lines from Job, I also was walking with some people who might have had the same questions. The answer comes from the psalmist. **"Praise the Lord, who heals the brokenhearted."**

Last Saturday, as I was about to start Mass, some young parents informed me of a terrible tragedy. A bright light, a beautiful young woman, with a great deal of potential, a senior in college, with many friends in our community, died tragically in a skiing accident in Colorado. Throughout the rest of the weekend, I received many calls and texts, sharing that same information. My sister-in-law, Monique called to let me know that the beautiful young woman was a dear friend of my niece, Kelly, and so many others in the parish. She told me that many were returning from their respective universities and coming to her house in Wilmette. She asked me if I would go and pray with them on Sunday afternoon. Of course, I agreed to go.

When I entered my brother and sister-in-law's house, beautiful young adults packed the living room, and loud cries could be heard. As I entered the living room, and saw the tears, I thought these young people might be asking the same question Job did, **"Will I ever see happiness again?"** As I reflect on that scene, the psalm gives me comfort, as I hoped to comfort the 21- and 22-year-olds, and their parents who filled the house that afternoon. **"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. He tells the number of the stars; he calls each by name."**

Early Monday morning, I received a call from a good friend, who has had quite a challenging last six months. His response to the challenges has always been super positive and very grateful. Many in his situation would become angry and bitter. He on the other hand, has faced his adversity with an attitude of gratitude and positivity, and has impressed me to no end. He has been able to see the silver lining in a very cloudy sky. Monday, he called me to tell me that his father died suddenly and unexpectedly, less than five years after his mother died the same way. One might think he might be asking Job's question, **"Is not man's life on earth a drudgery?"**


Instead, on that Monday morning, I heard the voice of the psalmist. **"Praise the Lord, who heals the brokenhearted."** In his voice I could hear this confidence, coming from Psalm 147. "Great is our Lord and mighty in power; to his

wisdom there is no limit. The Lord sustains the lowly; the wicked he casts to the ground."

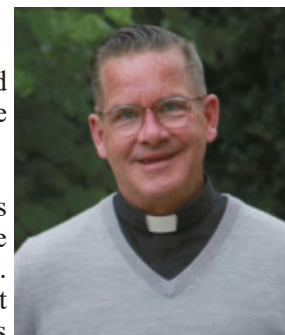
I think we all have our Job stories whether it's in our own life, or the lives of people we know and love. Suffering is real, and God is present in our suffering. The Gospel makes this abundantly clear. Jesus' healing of Simon's mother-in-law, and his proclamation that his mission was to preach, teach, and heal everywhere, reminds me of his greatness, and of my own call to bring his healing and mercy to those most in need. With my whole heart, I believe that the call is for all who call themselves Christian. Each of us, by virtue of our baptism, sent by Jesus, must bring God's healing, and God's mercy to the brokenhearted, to the ones who wonder if they'll ever see happiness again.

Each of us has the responsibility of supporting the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ. We all have been entrusted with great responsibility. Paul calls it stewardship; Cardinal Cupich calls it responsibility. Whatever one calls it, the action steps remain the same. We must ask God to heal our broken hearts and give of ourselves in advancing the Gospel. And woe to us if we don't do it.
