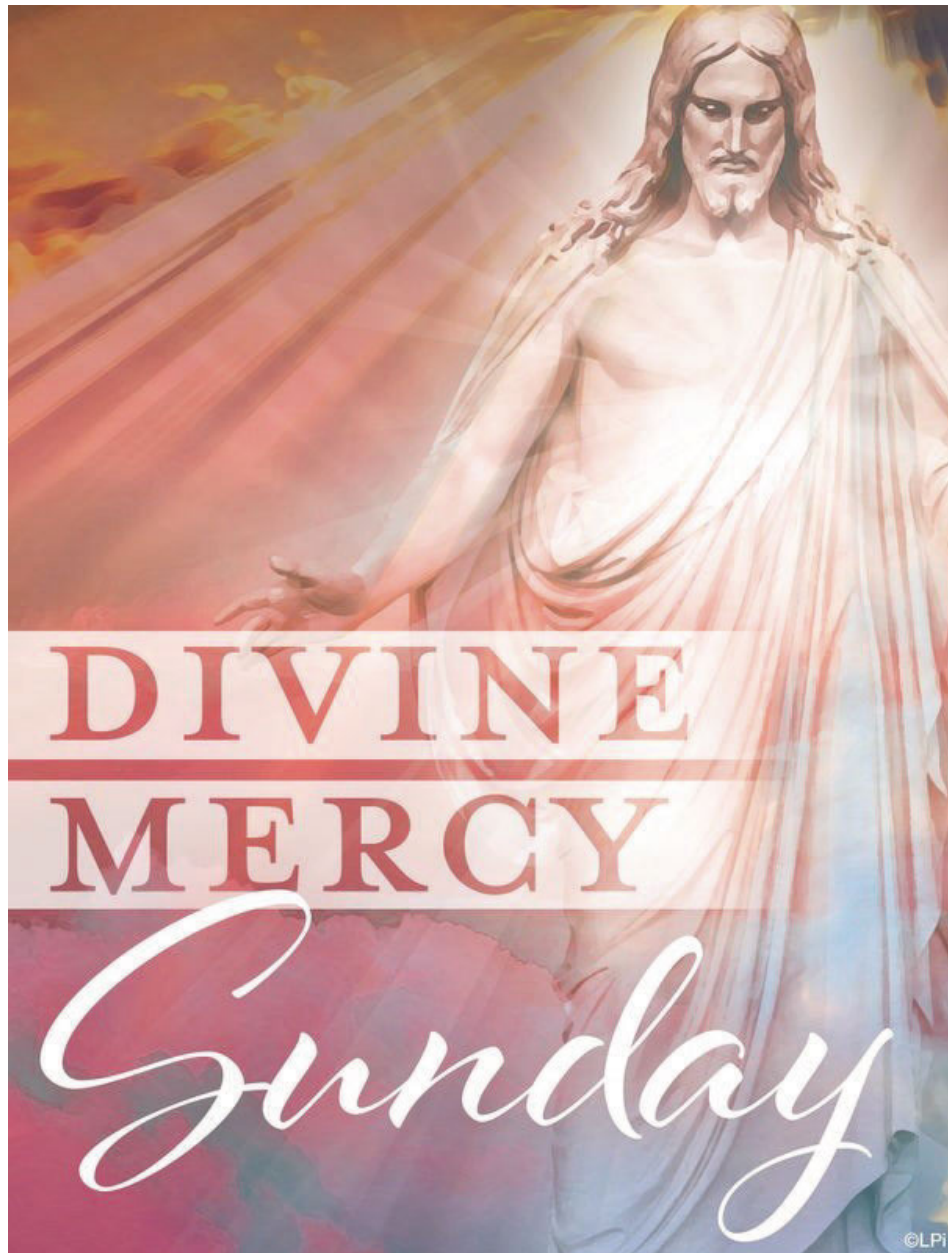

Dear Friends,

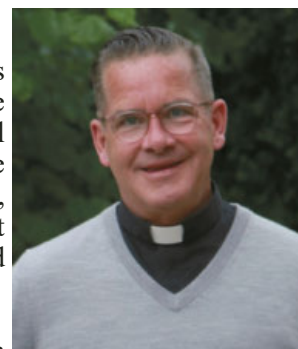
Grateful. Hopeful. Joyful. As I bask in the glow of Easter Week, and prepare for what is now called Divine Mercy Sunday, those “fuls” fill me. In case you missed it last Sunday, or Saturday, or Friday, or Thursday... Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier celebrated the Paschal Triduum in fine fashion. The environment, the music, the crowds, oh the crowds, inspired. In those three days, nearly four thousand people crossed the thresholds of our beautiful church homes. Over 600 attended Easter Mass at 9:30 and 900 joined us at the 10:30 Easter Mass alone. From the comments I heard after Mass, those that came left with sense of joy and hope - and feeling quite welcome. On Saturday evening, we welcomed *fifteen people* into our family of faith! So, to all those who made it happen, and to those who fill the pews each Sunday and make this community the great one that it is, I offer my heartfelt gratitude. **I am grateful.**

Throughout the Easter season, on Sundays and at the daily Masses, we will read from the Acts of the Apostles, Saint Luke's account of the early Church. The first line of the first reading for Sunday inspires and challenges me. “The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common.” As we read or listen to this passage, we ought to seek the point Luke makes. His story points to the oneness, the unity of the early Church. I am inspired to be a promoter of unity, and challenged to rid myself of anything that causes disunity. My words, spoken and written, and actions must serve to answer Jesus' prayer at the Last supper that we be one as he and the Father are one.

As we experience renewal in our own Church community, we can look to Acts to inspire our own Christian living. I have recently been introduced to an organization called *Acts XXIX Mobilizing for Mission*. You may know that there are twenty-eight chapters in the book of the Acts of the Apostles. This group of Catholic Evangelizers proposes that we are in the twenty-ninth chapter of the book. We continue the work of mission described in Luke's account of the early Church. If you have some time during this Easter season, I encourage you to visit their website (actsxxix.org), watch the videos or listen to the podcasts, and allow them to inspire you to be mobilized for the mission of evangelization. Our Church needs you!

As I read the first reading for this weekend's liturgies, I'm struck that Saint Luke's ideal Christian community, is exactly what we strive for here. That community was a place where all were welcome and a place where all the members shared whatever they had to help the others. This community does the same. Great favor was given to that

community, and great favor is given to this one. Sure we have some growing to do. We still could use a few hundred more actively committed members, intentional disciples, who commit to evangelizing themselves and the community.



We still need people to help with welcoming and with organizing parishioners in geographic areas of our parish. We still need families to commit to sacrificial financial support of our community (can I give a plug for electronic giving through Pushpay.com again?). But we are well on our way. We belong to a great community. The Holy Spirit is alive here and has created something very special. I believe that more and more of you will answer God's call. We are going places! **I am hopeful.**

These days remind me that we should pay as much attention to how we live the Easter season as we do the Lenten season. Easter gives us the reason for our gathering each Sunday. Christ's victory over sin and death certainly should be celebrated more than just for a day. We have fifty days to do so. We can celebrate Easter by witnessing to the difference it makes in our lives, and by sharing what we have with those who are in need. We can celebrate Easter by living with the joy of the resurrection in our hearts. We can celebrate Easter by committing to Sunday Mass and inviting others to join us. With enthusiasm, we can let our community know that great things are happening at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier! Because they are, because of so many other reasons, **I am joyful!**

Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is the main consultative body of the parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission.

The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as Stewardship, Hospitality, and Youth Faith Formation. This past year, one of our key accomplishments was the completion of a parish-wide survey.

Terms are 3 years, and the preferred number of members is 12. PPC has in-person meetings on the third Monday of the month at 7:30 pm. Work involves around 5 hours a month. Please contact the parish office at officessjfx@ssjfx.org to request the link to apply.

Finance Council assists the Pastor in discharging his responsibilities in the administration, management, and stewardship of the financial affairs of the parish. The Finance Council works with the Pastor and the Director of Operations in preparing and approving the annual budget, overseeing and approving major capital expenditures, and producing and communicating the Annual Report of the Parish Finances to Parishioners. Furthermore, the Council is charged with reviewing the operating results and providing important guidance in the financial management of the parish.

In addition to the monthly meeting, council volunteers are asked to work on sub-committees to actively work on Parish finance projects. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Finance Council is between 9 and 12.
