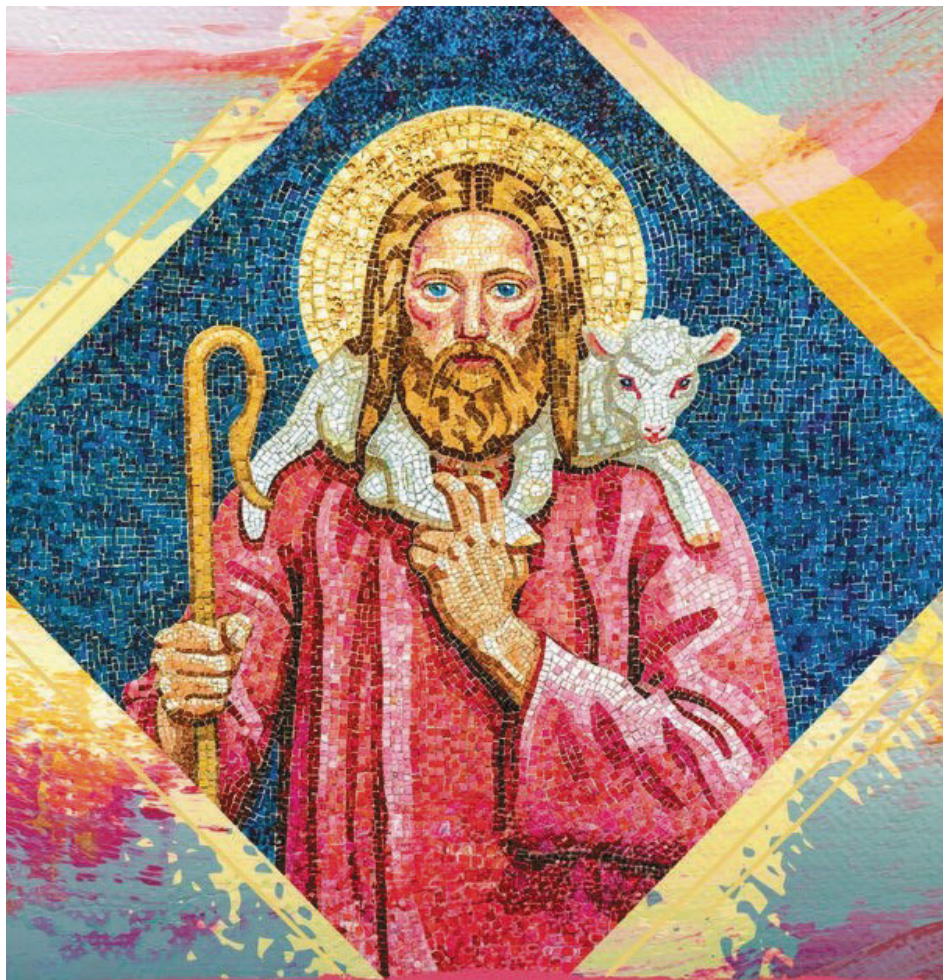

Dear Friends,

There are many times in life when experiences catch you by surprise. Not necessarily because something happened that surprised you, but because you surprised yourself with how you felt or reacted to a certain event or situation. Sometimes we think we truly know ourselves and how we are going to react to a given moment in time, but I can say I certainly learned quite a bit about myself and was very surprised with this year's OCIA experience.

Embarking on a journey for the first time is always exciting! This was my first attempt at leading a group of people on the exhilarating rollercoaster ride that is OCIA, to ultimately complete their total unification into our Mother Church. Starting in the Fall of 2023, a group of complete strangers gathered for the first time in the Saint Joseph community room. At the time for most of them (including me), the humble room was an average classroom style gathering place typical of most churches, however, this room soon became our cozy little refuge. When the OCIA sessions began an amazing presence of peace, love, and kindness filled the atmosphere of this average-looking place and turned into someplace special. As the months went on, these elements marinated and cooked together to form an unbelievably rich flavor of hospitality that engulfed the hearts of everyone present. We shared stories together, learned about the tenants of our faith, and gained insight on the intense love that Jesus shares with us through scripture. It was this message of love that ruled our sessions, and it surprised me just how in charge the Holy Spirit was.

When I first started here at SSJFX, I quickly learned that Fr. Wayne invites the Holy Spirit into literally whatever he is doing. I've never seen anyone live in quite this manner as he goes from decision to decision invoking the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit. This example of letting the Holy Spirit throw his weight around and own every situation, has radically changed the way I understand how God works in our lives. This was my first time leading an OCIA group to complete their sacraments, and I have to say, I was nervous. What I found myself starting to do was implementing this way of interacting and inviting the Holy Spirit into the OCIA situation.

Before every session I would pray that the Holy Spirit be present with us. Ask and you shall receive! The Holy Spirit was undoubtedly with us every step of the way as we journeyed toward learning about God and his salvation plan through our Lord Jesus. I was surprised as something very important became obvious to me. As a lay minister, I can come up with all sorts of different programs and ways to

explain our faith. I can get as creative as I like to try to help people learn about their faith and to connect with Jesus. While those are good efforts, and I will continue to try my best to create new approaches for faith connections, ultimately, it's the Holy Spirit who is in charge. I now understand that the Holy Spirit is the only one who can orchestrate people enrolling in OCIA classes, and it is only the power of the Holy Spirit that opens the hearts and minds of people- nobody else!

The Holy Spirit certainly surprised me as he opened my heart during this eight-month OCIA process. I didn't know I could care so much about people and their well-being. I didn't know I would get so involved in their journeys to faith. I didn't know that my heart was also changing alongside everyone else's during class. I didn't know I had the capacity to just let go, and let God have his way in everything. I did know how surprised I would be at Easter Vigil when I got a bit emotional seeing everyone complete their sacraments. I didn't know I would come to love all these participants like family members. I had not the slightest idea that there was such an intense love that transforms the heart while working in the OCIA program, I had no idea it felt like this. What can I say - I just didn't know how deeply this experience and my position here at SSJFX would impact and transform my life.

God works in funny and mysterious ways. He always has with me, but he really pulled a fast one during this OCIA experience, and completely showed me his intense love. I would like to just sincerely thank Fr. Wayne, Fr. Ryan, and the SSJFX staff for all their crucial support, and most importantly, the Holy Spirit for guiding us. Friends, hand everything in your life directly over to God, you will find yourself being very surprised in the most extraordinary ways!

Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is the main consultative body of the parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission.

The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as Stewardship, Hospitality, and Youth Faith Formation. This past year, one of our key accomplishments was the completion of a parish-wide survey.

Terms are 3 years, and the preferred number of members is 12. PPC has in-person meetings on the third Monday of the month at 7:30 pm. Work involves around 5 hours a month. Please contact the parish office at officessjfx@ssjfx.org to request the link to apply.

Finance Council assists the Pastor in discharging his responsibilities in the administration, management, and stewardship of the financial affairs of the parish. The Finance Council works with the Pastor and the Director of Operations in preparing and approving the annual budget, overseeing and approving major capital expenditures, and producing and communicating the Annual Report of the Parish Finances to Parishioners. Furthermore, the Council is charged with reviewing the operating results and providing important guidance in the financial management of the parish.

Meetings are held on the 4th Monday of the month, September – June. In addition to the monthly meeting, council volunteers are asked to work on sub-committees to actively work on Parish finance projects. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Finance Council is between 9 and 12.

The council is open to all parishioners and strives to have a mix of professional backgrounds including, but not limited to, finance, accounting, legal, marketing, consulting, and fundraising from both parish and school individuals across a range of age groups. 

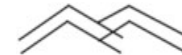

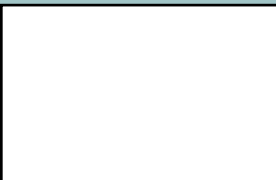
